The Singapore Youth Festival (SYF) was conceived in 1966 in post-independence Singapore and officially launched by President Yusof Ishak in 1967. Since then, it has grown and evolved and today marks a distinctive and anticipated season in the national school calendar. Organised annually by the Arts Education Branch (AEB) of the Ministry of Education (MOE), the SYF comprises three key platforms — the SYF Arts Presentation, SYF Art Exhibition, and SYF Celebrations — providing students with meaningful and authentic opportunities to learn and grow in and through the arts.

The Festival reflects MOE's belief in the importance of a holistic education for our students, and plays a key role in shaping the landscape of arts education in Singapore. Each year, it brings together more than 36,000 students from schools across Singapore, who participate in a diverse range of performing and visual arts — a testament to the festival's reach and enduring impact.

The SYF has remained a powerful and meaningful part of the school experience for generations of students over close to six decades — creating shared memories, emotional bonds, and lasting friendships through the unifying power of the arts.



ARTS EDUCATION BRANCH

The Arts Education Branch (AEB) oversees arts education across Singapore schools through strategic planning, policy development, capacity building and research. We lead curriculum and co-curricular development in Art, Dance, Drama, and Music. Our work also spans signature showcase platforms like the annual Singapore Youth Festival.

Guided by the belief that the arts can inspire and transform, we collaborate with educators, arts practitioners and organisations as well as cultural institutions to ensure quality arts learning is not only accessible to all students but an enduring and meaningful part of their lives.
