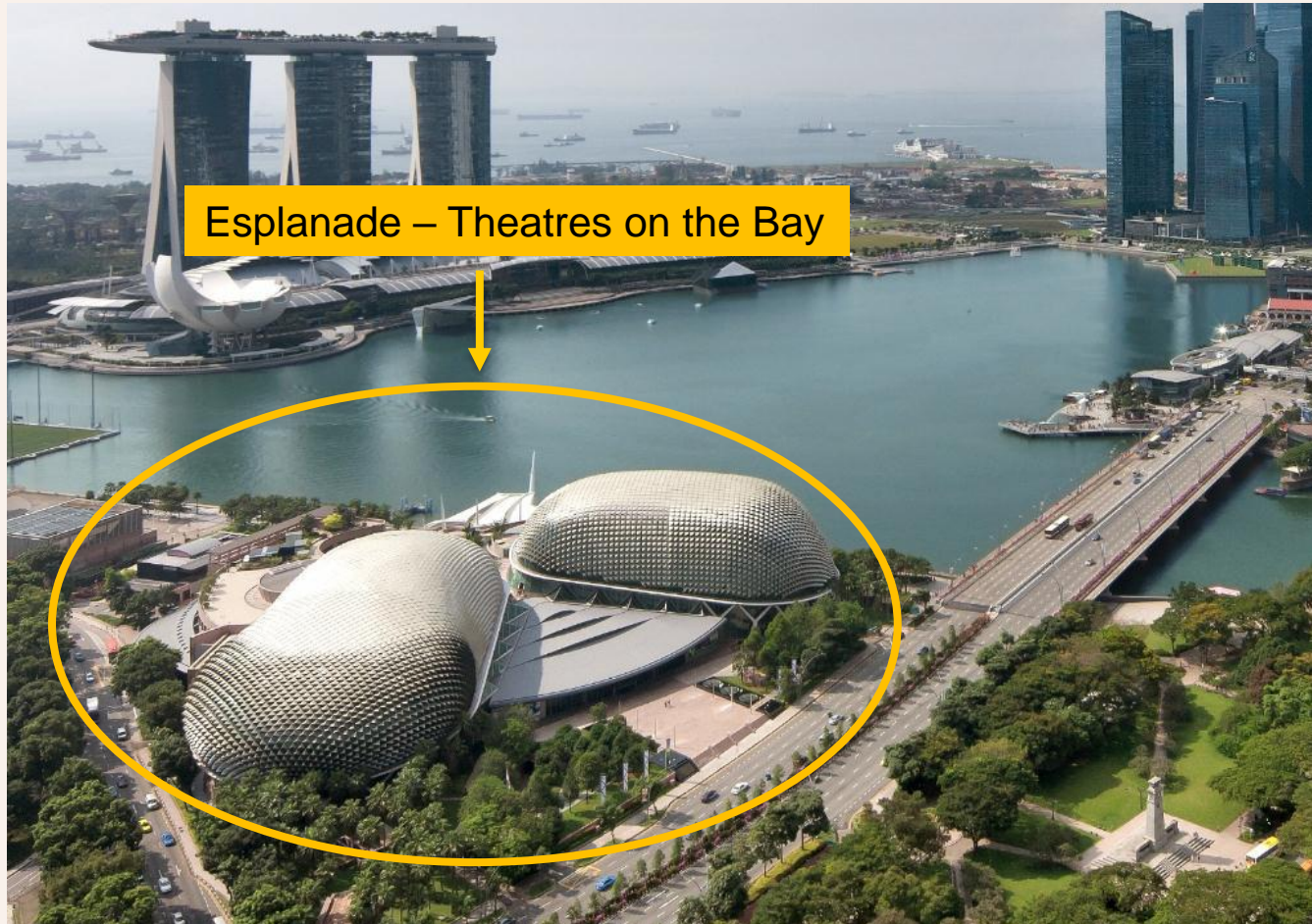

Getting into Esplanade

Theatre Studio

The show will take place at Theatre Studio.

The Theatre Studio is at **Level 4**.



Getting to Theatre Studio

I can get to the Theatre Studio from the Esplanade Mall Driveway.



I can also get to Theatre Studio from the Esplanade Basement Tunnel.

How to get to Theatre Studio From Esplanade Mall

Getting to Theatre Studio

This is how I get to Theatre Studio from Esplanade Mall. From the driveway, I can enter the Esplanade Mall through the glass doors.



There are lifts on the right.

Getting to Theatre Studio

The Theatre Studio is at Level 4.

I can take the lift from Level 1 to Level 4.



Once I reach Level 4, Theatre Studio is right at the end! I have arrived at my destination.

How to get to Theatre Studio from Basement 1 Tunnel



Getting to Theatre Studio

This is how I get to the Theatre Studio from Basement 1 tunnel.

There is a glass door at Basement 1. I can enter here.

Getting to Theatre Studio

To get to Theatre Studio, I must first get to Level 2.

From Basement 1, I can take lift A or lift B to go straight to Level 2.

I can also take the escalators to go to the Mezzanine level first.

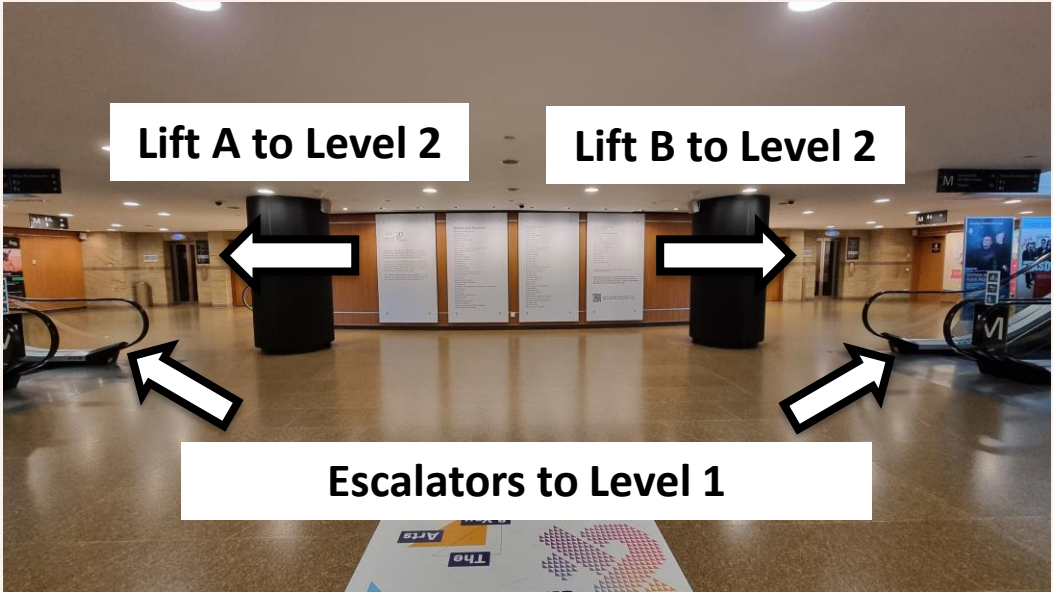


Getting to Theatre Studio

This is the Mezzanine level. If I took the escalator at Basement 1, I would see this.

I can take lift A or B to Level 2.

I can also take the escalators to Level 1.

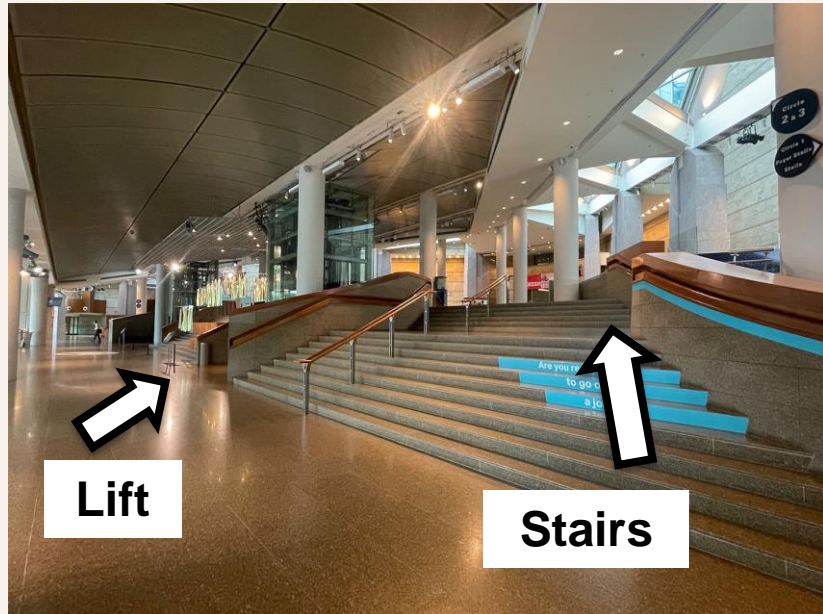

Getting to Theatre Studio

At Level 1, I can use the stairs or lift to go up to Level 2.



I am at Level 2.

At Level 2, I will go straight and through Theatre Street. There are shops to the left and right.



Getting to Theatre Studio

At the end of Theatre Street, I will turn left. I will continue going straight.

To get to Theatre Studio, I need to go up to Level 4.



I can turn right and take the escalator up to Level 3.

I can also turn left and take the lift directly to Level 4.



Getting to Theatre Studio

If I take the escalator, I will get to Level 3. From Level 3, I will have to take another escalator up to Level 4.

Once I reach Level 4, I will reach the Theatre Studio!

This is where the show will take place.

Toilets

Before I go in to watch the show, I can go to the toilet.

To get to the toilet, I will go up the stairs and turn left.

I can also go to the toilet during the show.

Toilets

These toilets are for children like me. They are located opposite PIP's PLAYbox.

If an adult wants to use the toilet, they can use the toilet nearby.





Hand dryer

In the toilet, there is a hand dryer.

It makes a loud noise when someone uses it.

The noise will stop after a while.

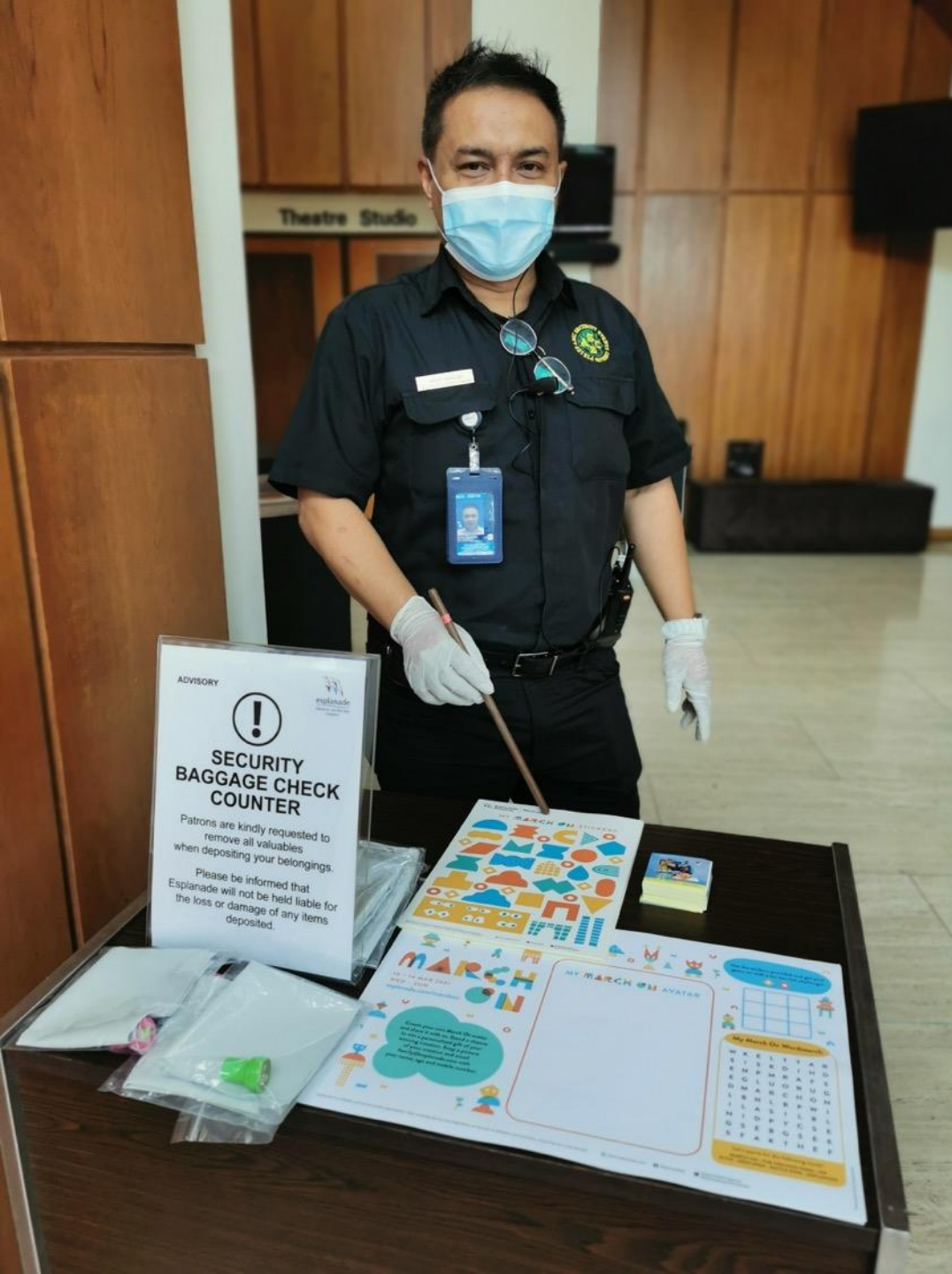


Ushers

Before I go into the Theatre Studio, ushers will greet me at the door.

Ushers are dressed in blue and will have masks on.

They will check my ticket.



Bag check

If I have a bag, a security officer will check my bag.

Inside Theatre Studio



The theatre

This is the theatre.

A theatre is a room where a show takes place.

The theatre will be a little dark. Some lights will be turned on to help me see.



Where to sit

When I am in the theatre, an usher will show me where to sit.

I can sit on the floor, cushions or ask an usher for a chair.



Moving about

If I want to move or dance **on the spot** during the show, that is okay.

If I need to go to the toilet during the show, that is okay. An adult or an usher can show me the way to the toilet.

Calming Hut

This is the calming hut.

If I want to look for a quieter place in the theatre, I can go to the calming hut.

I can go back to my seat when I am ready.





Calming Space

Sometimes, I want to leave the theatre when the show is happening and look for a quiet place. That is okay too. I can go out to the calming space.

This is the calming space. It is outside the theatre.

I can go back into the theatre anytime when I feel ready.



Ear Protector

This is an ear protector.

If it gets too loud, I can ask an usher for a set. If I have my own ear protector, I can use it too.

Wearing it over my ears will help make the sound softer so that I can continue to enjoy the show.

Characters in *Together*



Actor

An actor is someone who acts.

An actor plays a role and pretends to be a character in the show. They can sometimes play more than one character.

I will see these actors in the show.



Actor 1 – Rebecca

This is Rebecca.

She plays a character named Mei Mei.

Mei Mei loves penguins and mermaids.
She loves playing games and is afraid
of the dark and cockroaches.



Actor 2 – Irsyad

This is Irsyad.

He plays a character named Gor Gor.

Gor Gor loves robots and is fascinated by outer space. He enjoys playing with Mei Mei but dislikes it when she disturbs his iPad time.



Actor 3 – Elizabeth

This is Elizabeth.

She plays the role of Ma.

Ma is Mei Mei and Gor Gor's mother. She is very busy with work but wishes she could spend more time playing with Meimei and Gorgor.



Actor 3 – Elizabeth

You will also see Elizabeth act as Astronaut, Pink Penguin and Giant Glow Fish.

They are friends Mei Mei and Gor Gor meet when they go on adventures together.

This is Elizabeth as Astronaut. Astronaut is lost in Space World and needs help to get home.

Actor 3 – Elizabeth

This is Elizabeth as Pink Penguin.
Pink Penguin needs Mei Mei and Gor
Gor's help with the Egglings.





Actor 3 – Elizabeth

This is Elizabeth as Giant Glow Fish. Giant Glow Fish lives in the Ocean with Little Glow Fish and Mermaids.

Actor 4 – Genevieve

This is Genevieve.

She plays the role of Mr. Cockroach.

Mr. Cockroach is a mysterious character that seems to have the power to bring Mei Mei and Gor Gor through doors to magical worlds.





Actor 4 – Genevieve

You will also see Genevieve acting as the Egglings and Little Glow Fishes.

The Egglings and Little Glow Fishes are children of Pink Penguin and Big Glow Fish. They always appear in pairs—just like Mei Mei and Gor Gor!

This is Genevieve acting as the Egglings.

Actor 4 – Genevieve

This is Genevieve playing the Little Glow Fishes.

Doors

Mei Mei and Gor Gor go through doors to travel to different worlds using their imagination.

These doors can move around the space and light up in different colours.



Different Worlds

Mei Mei and Gor Gor travel to different worlds during the show.

This is Space World where they meet Astronaut. It is made up of five different planets created from paper lanterns.



Different Worlds

This is Penguin Poopoo land where they meet Penguin and the Egglings. It is made up of balloons.



Different Worlds

This is Robot land which also looks like a storeroom. This is where they meet Robot 5512.



Different Worlds

This is the Ocean. This is where they meet Big Glow Fish and Little Glow Fishes. The Ocean is made up of umbrellas.
