About Esplanade – Theatres on the Bay

Esplanade is Singapore's national performing arts centre. It hosts a year-round line-up of about 3,500 live performances and activities presented by Esplanade, its partners and hirers. As an arts centre for everyone, Esplanade also creates opportunities for seniors, youth, children and underserved communities to experience the arts. More than 70% of the shows that take place each year at the centre are free for all to enjoy.

Esplanade also brings the arts virtually to audiences in Singapore and beyond, through its diverse range of digital programmes on *Esplanade Offstage*, an all-access backstage pass to the performing arts and guide to Singapore and Asian arts and culture, with videos, podcasts, articles, quizzes and resources.

The centre works in close partnership with local, regional and international artists to develop artistic capabilities and content, push artistic boundaries and engage audiences. Esplanade supports the creation of artistic content by commissioning and producing new Singapore and Asian work for the international stage. It also develops technical capabilities for the industry nationally.

Esplanade – Theatres on the Bay is operated by The Esplanade Co Ltd (TECL), which is a not-for-profit organisation, a registered Charity and an Institution of a Public Character. The Charity Council awarded TECL the Charity Governance Award – Special Commendation for Clarity of Strategy in 2016 and 2022, and the Charity Transparency Award from 2016 – 2019 and 2022. Esplanade is Singapore's first Dementia-Friendly Arts Venue and a certified Dementia Go-To Point, as well as a Guide-dog Friendly centre.

TECL receives funding support from Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth and its Community Programmes are supported by Tote Board Family, comprising Tote Board, Singapore Pools and Singapore Turf Club.

Synopsis

Adam is sent away by his mother, Siti, to undergo the rite of passage of every Singaporean son: National Service. Except, he was born in Australia and has no sense of what Singapore means to him. His return is further complicated by Siti's overzealous need for him to rekindle the ties she severed a long time ago — and experience the quintessential rite of passage of every Singaporean Malay son: circumcision.

Aided by an uncle and grandmother who are not quite what they seem and an out of sorts 'maker of men' doctor, Adam journeys to be a man.

Potong is a theatrical journey that weaves together a rich tapestry of characters and intertwining experiences to unravel the intricate web of self-definition and the role of memories in shaping it. Liberally punctuated with both humour and pain, the play invites you to navigate the complexities around family, humanity, and love.

Written by Johnny Jon Jon and directed by Mohd Fared Jainal, *Potong* was first presented as part of Teater Ekamatra's 2018 main season offering, a company recognised for its honest, tender, and sensitive approach to thorny issues. This iteration stars actress Farah Ong in her original role, alongside performers Aisyah Aziz, Irsyad Dawood, and Jada.

Aisyah Aziz

Recognised for her sultry, sensual vocals as a singer-songwriter, Aisyah Aziz is well-known for her ability to switch from full to head voice, and being able to tackle a dynamic range of music genres. Jada, a graduate of NAFA's Diploma in Dance, has been performing since the tender age of 16 years old, both locally and internationally. Jada's first debut performance was in a theatrical production, *Dhavusya* by Teater Ekamatra in 1997. Jada has since explored being an actor, director, choreographer, and consultant before moving to Kuala Lumpur in 2000. Since semi-retiring from show business in 2016, Jada

has worked as a makeup artist, barista, and most recently, a florist. Jada is now coming full circle to return to theatre, and is re-debuting with the role 'Saleh' in *Potong*.

Jada hopes to learn and grow through this role, and also to experience how the theatre scene has evolved, and hopes that more performing opportunities may present itself.

Fared engages in cross-disciplinary work that delves into visual and performing arts, with a particular interest in space, body and design. A strong advocate of physical theatre, he is constantly exploring body craft in performance. He is also studying the relationships between elements, principles of art and the human self, asserting these links to be in symmetry and simultaneously manipulative.

Mesej Pengarang Drama

Apabila saya mula-mula menulis “Potong”, ia sepatutnya mengisahkan seorang kanak-kanak lelaki liar yang berjumpa dengan Pari-Pari Kulup (seperti Pari-Pari Gigi tetapi berlainan dalam industri Pari-Pari). Tetapi sedang saya terus menulis cerita tentang seorang pari-pari yang tinggal di pinggiran’, ia kemudian berubah menjadi refleksi tentang orang yang tinggal di pinggiran.

Dalam “Potong”, saya mengambil inspirasi daripada cerita-cerita mereka yang tinggal di pinggiran. Ada mungkin lebih jelas daripada yang lain dan anda fikir anda, di luar, melihat mereka dari dalam. Tetapi, saya fikir dalam “Potong”, anda akan mencari saat-saat, di mana, anda mengalami pengalaman anda sendiri. Mungkin, kita tinggal di pinggiran? Dengan menyelami kehidupan watak-watak ini, saya harap ada refleksi tentang perjalanan dan pengalaman kita sendiri dan ada perbualan yang tercetus antara ‘pinggiran’ atau ruang.

Saya mengambil peluang ini untuk mengucapkan terima kasih kepada pasukan-pasukan dari Ekamatra dan Esplanade kerana sudi mengadakan perbualan ini dan saya berterima kasih kepada anda semua kerana menyertai perbualan tersebut.

Mesej Pengarah

Selamat datang semua! Seperti yang anda mungkin sudah dengar, ini adalah masa yang menggembirakan bagi kami kerana kami memasuki lembaran baru dalam sejarah Ekamatra dengan kepimpinan baru! Saya ghairah ingin melihat bagaimana mereka akan membina asas kerja keras syarikat, dan pada masa yang sama, membuka peluang supaya syarikat dapat mencapai lebih banyak kekuatan, inspirasi, keberanian, dan kasih sayang.

Kami mula tahun ini dengan sebuah pementasan tentang kesediaan untuk menyerahkan nyawa seseorang, dan untuk melepaskan sesuatu yang berharga, dalam perjalanan untuk mencari kebenaran dan penerimaan. Pengorbanan dilihat melampaui diri demi nilai. Lebih-lebih lagi, ia mengenai komitmen dan tanggung jawab.

Peluang untuk menerokai semula Potong tiba pada waktu yang tepat apabila definisi dan keperibadian menjadi preskripsi untuk menjadi tempat kita di dunia. Keinginan untuk dilihat, pilihan untuk bersembunyi, perasaan diam, semuanya berperanan dalam menentukan siapa kita. Dan ini semua adalah pelbagai lapisan berwarna-warni yang muncul di dalam watak-watak dan dunia *Potong*.

Sinopsis

Adam dihantar ibunya, Siti, untuk menjalani tuntutan setiap anak lelaki Singapura: Perkhidmatan Negara. Namun, beliau dilahirkan di Australia dan tiada perasaan terhadap Singapura. Kepulangannya menjadi lebih rumit apabila Siti dengan bersemangat mahu Adam kembali menjalin hubungan yang sudah lama terputus - dan mengalami upacara yang dikehendaki setian anak lelaki Melayu Singapura: bersunat.

Dengan bantuan seorang pak cik dan nenek yang agak aneh dan konon-kononnya, ‘doktor buat kaum lelaki’, Adam melalui pengalaman untuk menjadi seorang lelaki.

Potong adalah satu perjalanan teaterikal yang menyatukan pelbagai watak menarik dan pengalaman untuk merungkai jalinan definisi diri yang rumit dan peranan kenangan untuk membentuknya. Padat dengan humor dan kesakitan, karya pementasan ini mengundang anda untuk mengemudi kerumitan di kalangan keluarga, kemanusiaan dan kasih sayang.

Ditulis oleh Johnny Jon Jon dan diarah oleh Mohd Fared Jainal, *Potong* pertama kali dipersembahkan sebagai sebahagian daripada musim utama Teater Ekamatra pada 2018, sebuah syarikat yang terkenal dengan pendekatan jujur, lembut dan sensitif terhadap isu-isu sukar dan rumit. Pementasan ini memaparkan pelakon Farah Ong dalam peranan asalnya, di sisi pelakon Aisyah Aziz, Irsyad Dawood, dan Jada.

Aisyah Aziz

Dikenali dengan suara lunak dan sensual sebagai penyanyi-penulis lagu, Aisyah Aziz dikenali dengan keupayaannya untuk berubah daripada suara penuh pada suara kepala, kededuanya suara merdu, dan boleh menangani genre muzik dinamik yang luas. Beliau telah bergabung dengan ramai seniman bertauliah lain termasuk Charlie Lim, ShiGGa Shay dan Lil J. dari Malaysia. Aisyah juga telah dikomisyen oleh FASE dan NDP untuk penulisan lagu.

Aisyah pertama kali tampil dalam pementasan teater dalam muzikal yang telah meraih anugerah, *Bangsawan Gemala Malam* oleh Teater Ekamatra yang dikomisyen oleh Festival Seni Antarabangsa Singapura 2022. Pada tahun ini, Aisyah Aziz kembali tampil di atas pentas buat kali kedua sebagai Dr Dini dalam *Potong*.



Irsyad Dawood

Irsyad Dawood adalah seorang persembahan dan pembuat teater, di antara banyak perkara. Amalannya berpusat dikelilingi pelbagai jenis persembahan termasuk, tetapi tidak terhad pada, lakonan, persembahan boneka, dan persembahan seni. Antara senarai karya persembahannya termasuk *T0701* (Zeugma), *Bangsawan Gemala Malam* (Teater Ekamatra) dan *Pandancemic* (Muzium Seni Singapura).

Beliau mendedikasi setiap karyanya pada ibu dan allahyarham bapanya yang beliau cintai.



Jada

Jada, lulusan Diploma dalam Tarian dari Akademi Seni Halus Nanyang (NAFA) telah membuat persembahan sejak usia muda 16 tahun, di Singapura dan antarabangsa. Persembahan pertama Jada adalah dalam sebuah penerbitan teater, *Dhavusya* oleh Teater Ekamatra pada 1997. Jada, sejak itu telah menerokai menjadi seorang pelakon, pengarah, koreografer dan konsultan sebelum berpindah ke Kuala Lumpur pada

2000. Sejak separuh bersara daripada bidang hiburan pada 2016, Jada telah bekerja sebagai seorang jurumekap, barista dan baru-baru ini, penggubah bunga. Jada kini kembali ke teater dan muncul semula dengan peranan sebagai Saleh dalam *Potong*.

Jada berharap dapat belajar dan berkembang menerusi peranan ini, dan juga mengalami sendiri perkembangan industri teater, dengan harapan agar peluang persembahan akan hadir sendiri.



Farah Ong

Farah Ong adalah seorang seniman berdikari - seorang pelakon, seniman persembahan, seniman suara, pengarah teater kanak-kanak dan seniman pengajar.

Farah berasa paling bernyawa semasa beliau melakukan persembahan. Beliau mendapati perhubungan manusia sangat menyenangkan semasa mengajar. Beliau cuba memahami sakit semasa mencipta persembahan.

Beliau mencipta seni, kadang-kala dalam cara dan bentuk luar biasa.

Apabila tidak mencipta seni, beliau adalah manusia biasa seperti apa ramai orang inginkan - untuk melakukan sesuatu, untuk menyayangi seseorang dan untuk melakukan beberapa kegiatan bermakna.

Beliau percaya, tidak kira berapa tua atau berapa letih kita sudah jadi - jika kita lihat dunia ini menerusi mata kanak-kanak, ada magis dalam semuanya.

Farah sentiasa seorang kanak-kanak di dalam hati.

Johnny Jon Jon

Pengarang Drama

Jon Jon mempelajari bahasa Inggeris di Universiti Teknologi Nanyang, di mana, beliau juga melakukan minor dalam penulisan kreatif di bawah bimbingan penyair Jen Crawford. Sementara beliau merupakan seorang pengarang drama, Jon Jon juga terlibat dalam penulisan fiksyen pendek, dan telah menulis pelbagai obituary untuk dirinya. *Potong* adalah pementasan drama panjang kedua Jon Jon dan mungkin, terakhir buatnya.



Mohd Fared Jainal

Pengarah

Fared terlibat dalam kerja rentas disciplinary yang melibatkan seni persembahan dan visual, dengan minat khusus dalam ruang, badan dan reka bentuk. Seorang penyokong kuat teater fizikal, beliau sering menerokai seni badan dalam persembahan. Beliau juga mengkaji hubungan antara elemen, prinsip seni dan diri manusia, menegaskan hubungan ini berada dalam simetri dan pada masa yang sama, manipulatif.

Fared telah banyak bergabung dengan pelbagai kumpulan seni dan teater di Singapura sebagai seorang pengarah, penghibur, seniman visual dan pereka set. Beliau adalah anggota pengasas neontights, satu kolektif rekaan teater yang mencipta set pentas inovatif dan alat-alat prop. Fared juga mengajar di School of the Arts (SOTA).



Wong Chee Wai

Pereka Set

Chee Wai adalah seorang pereka set bebas sepenuh masa. Beliau telah mereka bentuk dan bekerja dengan pelbagai syarikat seniman persembahan di Singapura. Beberapa karya terbarunya termasuk WILD RICE's *The Importance of Being Earnest*, *Merdeka* and *Emily of Emerald Hill*.



Alberta Wileo

Pereka pencahayaan

Karya rekaannya mula pada 2002 untuk pertunjukan tamat pengajian tarian di Kolej Seni LASALLE apabila beliau seorang pelajar di sana, dalam jurusan seni teater teknikal. Beliau juga telah menerbitkan karya rekaan untuk pelbagai syarikat persembahan profesional seperti antaranya, Arts Fission, Action Theatre, Teater Repertori Singaura, Opera Lirik Singapura dan Orkestra Simfoni Singapura.

Albert juga telah menawarkan karya rekaan untuk pelbagai sekolah, gereja, konsert dan syarikat-syarikat acara di Singapura dan Indonesia. Beliau adalah pereka pencahayaan utama untuk Festival Seni Indonesia dari 2003 hingga 2013 yang diadakan di Esplanade dan pada 2015 di Panggung Victoria yang disokong oleh kedutaan Indonesia di Singapura.

Albert adalah seorang pereka pencahayaan yang selalu dicari-cari untuk kedua penerbitan tarian kontemporari dan tradisional dan karya teater di Singapura. Sepanjang tahun, beliau telah menempa nama dengan menghasilkan karya reka bentuk pencahayaan bermutu baik dengan penonton dan penggabung.



Safuan Johari

Pereka Bunyi

Safuan Johari adalah seorang pereka bunyi dan penerbit muzik Singapura yang telah menghasilkan pelbagai seni pemasangan multimedia dan penerbitan persembahan. Beliau juga telah menggubah dan menerbitkan muzik untuk teater, tarian dan filem. Safuan sering membayangkan semula budaya silam menerusi lensa teknologikal dan digital. Ia sudah melebihi sedekad sejak Safuan mula melakukan projek audio-visual, dan baru-baru ini sedang menerokai visualisasi bunyi sendiri. Ini mengakibatkan penyelaman mendalam ke dalam seni ‘generative’, mewujudkan sistem autonomi dan telah ditetapkan untuk menghasilkan gubahan sonik yang boleh memodulasi seni visual.

Safuan telah membuat pameran dan persembahan di Beijing, Paris, London dan New York. Di Singapura, beliau telah memaparkan karyanya di Festival Malam Singaura, i-Light Marina Bay, Festival Seni Antarabangsa Singapura dan Festival Fringe Singapura. Safuan juga adalah sebahagian daripada NADA, sebuah projek bunyi dan seni visual yang mencari sekitaran bunyian hantu dan mencari masa depan yang hilang.
