

 If I need to use the washroom during the performance, that is alright. An adult or an usher can show me the way to the washroom located outside the venue. After using the washroom, I can ask an adult or an usher to show me back to my seat.

#### Calm Space


 Sometimes, I want to leave my seat when the performance is happening and look for a place to calm down anywhere in Esplanade. I can do that.

 I can go back to my seat in the Concert Hall any time during the performance when I am ready.


 A Calm Space at the Concert Hall is located on Level 2, at The Bay Room.




- If I am on Level 1, when I come out of the Concert Hall, I will take the staircase up to Level 2.
- If I need help, I can ask an usher to show me the way.



- If I am on Level 3, when I come out of the Concert Hall, I will take the staircase down to Level 2.
- If I need help, I can ask an usher to show me the way.



- If I am on Level 4, when I come out of the Concert Hall, I will take the staircase down two floors to Level 2.
- If I need help, I can ask an usher to show me the way.



 At Level 2, facing the direction where the glass windows are on my right, I will head to the end of the corridor.



• I will continue walking straight ahead.



- I have arrived at The Bay Room. This is where the Calm Space is located.
- I can go inside to use the Calm Space.

 I can rest here and whenever I am ready, I can head back to the Concert Hall to enjoy the rest of the performance.
