- I will find my seat in the Concert Hall using my ticket. An usher may also assist me.


#### Moving about




- If I want to move or dance on the spot during the performance, that is alright.

- I can go back to my seat in the Concert Hall when I am ready.
- A Calm Space at the Concert Hall is located on Level 2, at The Bay Room.




- If I am on Level 1, when I come out of the Concert Hall, I will take the staircase up to Level 2.
- If I need help, I can ask an usher to show me the way.



- If I am on Level 3, when I come out of the Concert Hall, I will take the staircase down to Level 2.
- If I need help, I can ask an usher to show me the way.



- If I am on Level 4, when I come out of the Concert Hall, I will take the staircase down two floors to Level 2.
- If I need help, I can ask an usher to show me the way.



 At Level 2, facing the direction where the glass windows are on my right, I will head to the end of the corridor.



I will continue walking straight ahead.



- I have arrived at The Bay Room. This is where the Calm Space is located.
- I can go inside to use the Calm Space.
