About Esplanade - Theatres on the Bay

Esplanade is Singapore's national performing arts centre. It hosts a year-round line-up of about 4,000 live performances and activities presented by Esplanade, its partners and hirers. As an arts centre for everyone, Esplanade also creates opportunities for seniors, youth, children and underserved communities to experience the arts. More than 70% of the shows that take place each year at the centre are free for all to enjoy.

Esplanade also brings the arts virtually to audiences in Singapore and beyond, through its diverse range of digital programmes on *Esplanade Offstage*, an all-access backstage pass to the performing arts and guide to Singapore and Asian arts and culture, with videos, podcasts, articles, quizzes and resources.

The centre works in close partnership with local, regional and international artists to develop artistic capabilities and content, push artistic boundaries and engage audiences. Esplanade supports the creation of artistic content by commissioning and producing new Singapore and Asian work for the international stage. It also develops technical capabilities for the industry nationally.

Esplanade – Theatres on the Bay is operated by The Esplanade Co Ltd (TECL), which is a not-for-profit organisation, a registered Charity and an Institution of a Public Character. TECL received the Charity Governance Award – Special Commendation for Clarity of Strategy in 2016 and 2022, the Charity Transparency Award from 2016 – 2023, and the Charity Transparency Dedication Award in 2024. Esplanade is Singapore's first Dementia-Friendly Arts Venue and a certified Dementia Go-To Point, as well as a guide/assistance dog friendly centre.

TECL receives funding support from Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth and its Community Programmes are supported by Tote Board Family, comprising Tote Board, Singapore Pools and Singapore Turf Club.

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FESTIVAL MESSAGE

In the early days of my career, I had a hard time describing my work to my parents and relatives. With the job title "Programmer", they inevitably thought I was an IT guy. Over the years, I would find opportunities to take them to performances and explain what I do. Today, my relatives not only attend *Huayi – Chinese Festival of Arts*, they are even more anxious than I to be the first to hear about the lineup! If there was a simple way to describe how this festival is put together, it is this: to connect top-notch performances and themes with various groups of people and their desires or needs. The 23rd edition of *Huayi*, held from 7 – 16 Feb 2025, reinforces the festival's tenet to have something engaging and meaningful for everyone.

Our two productions in the Esplanade Theatre will appeal to anyone who loves a good story. Even though Lao She wrote the story of *Rickshaw Boy* in the 1930s, modern day rickshaw boys are everywhere – the ubiquitous food delivery guys on their bikes trying their best to make a good and honest living. Arriving in Singapore on the back of a hugely successful tour of major cities in China, *Rickshaw Boy* is helmed by award-winning director Fang Xu. And in acclaimed Taiwanese theatre company Greenray's *Human Condition VIII*, the main protagonist dreams of winning the lottery – isn't that a wish many people can identify with?

How does one stay active and mobile in the sunset years? What do friendships—or the dearth of them—look like? These are the themes explored in the dance production *Dance with Me* by choreographer Low Mei Yoke, recipient of the Cultural Medallion. These themes are also explored in *Last Luncheon*, the solo play directed, written and performed by Singapore theatre stalwart Alvin Chiam.

At a time where AI is poised to take over the world, traditions and how to keep them relevant are explored in three riveting music productions What is Qin by Zi De Guqin Studio of China, The Temple of Resonance by Taiwan's Uni Percussion, and The Heart of Jun: Memoirs of Zhaojun by Singapore nanyin ensemble Siong Leng Musical Association in collaboration with Taiwanese director Lee Yi Hsiu.

Songwriters are the poets of everyday life. *Huayi 2025's in::music platform* presents a bumper crop of excellent songwriters, beginning with Taiwan's Golden Melody Award winner and indie darling ANPU, followed by Hong Kong's Yoyo Sham, Taiwan's GoodBand and Singapore's Boon Hui Lu.

As for the little ones, don't they love to be able to indulge to their hearts' content in sweets, gummies and chocolates? Adapted from the tale of Hansel and Gretel, Candy House in the Mountain by Bon Appétit Theatre of Taiwan is a fusion of storytelling and foley. This production encourages

children to listen to the Chinese language and the many sound effects, as well as to activate their imagination. Another storyteller who will have audiences eating out of the palm of her hand is Malaysian artist Cheryl Lee, well known across the Causeway for her hilarious brand of Cantonese stand-up comedy.

Aside from a wide spectrum of works that will move you deeply or have you rolling with laughter, *Huayi* also seeks to put the 'festive' in 'festival'. Held during the Chinese New Year period every year, it gives us an opportunity to wish everyone who comes to Esplanade for the festival a bounteous year ahead, filled with luck, good health and prosperity. As producers and programmers behind the festival, we set the stage for celebration.

PLAYWRIGHT & DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

This time, it feels like the story is about myself—like looking into a mirror while shaving, observing closely, and feeling a slight sting.

I am 72 years old this year, and most people at my age have already retired. But are they truly living a serene life of "remaining undisturbed by worldly matters, enjoying the breeze and the moonlight?" Not necessarily. What do you think?



In reality, many older individuals who have lost their tangible roles in society, family or the workplace, still quietly harbour hopes of being respected, heard, and needed. Some even hold onto unfulfilled dreams and longings, don't they? Otherwise, why would there be a saying like "Life begins at 70", which often draws amused smiles from younger generations?

SYNOPSIS

Mingcan, a retiree who finds himself adrift and without a purpose in life.

His status as a respected patriarch has long disappeared as his adult children have their own families and lives to deal with. Unable to contribute to the economy and unneeded by his family, Mingcan questions his self-worth as his dignity slowly fades with each listless, monotonous day.





Just as he feels that he has struck rock-bottom, he instead strikes the lottery jackpot, and immediately finds himself to be of interest to his family once more.

Mingcan feels respected, needed, wanted. But is this unexpected windfall a stroke of luck or a harbinger of misfortune?

ABOUT GREENRAY THEATRE COMPANY

Since its establishment in 1993, Greenray Theatre Company has produced many theatre works, categorised into five series: Original Musical, National Theatre, World Theatre, Taiwan Literary Theatre, and Urban Life Theatre, altogether comprising more than 40 works. In 2021, episodes one to six of the *Human Condition* series were broadcast online and received a record 2.8 million views.

In 2022, Greenray Theatre Company announced the establishment of Greenray Inc., with Wu Nien-jen as the chairman, to diversify the IP of stage plays and to convert them into different forms of cultural entertainment—literature, film and television, theatre, music, and video games—in order to promote the interconnection and integration of the multicultural entertainment market.

CHEN HSI-SHENGMingcan

Chen Hsi-sheng graduated from the Department of Drama at the National Institute of the Arts, majoring in acting. Since 1987, he has participated in numerous stage productions as both a performer and producer. In recent years, he has primarily focused on film and television drama production. Passionate about acting, he has appeared in several Taiwanese films and TV series.



WANG CHUANMingcan's wife

Wang Chuan is a co-founder of the Comedians Workshop and an adjunct associate professor at the Graduate Institute of Performing Arts, National Taiwan Normal University. After years of dedication to stage plays, she ventured into screen acting in 2003. In 2004, she was nominated for Best Leading Actress

at the Golden Horse Awards for her performance in *Blue Cha Cha*. In 2016, she won the Best Supporting Actress award in a Miniseries/Television Film for *Goodbye*, *Daughter*. To date, she has received numerous nominations and awards at the Golden Bell Awards.



SAM YANGMingcan's son

Sam Yang is the lead vocalist of Fire EX. and currently serves as the CEO of FIRE ON MUSIC. Fire EX. has been a band for 23 years, beloved by fans for its straightforward, heartfelt lyrics, fast-paced rhythms, moving melodies, and energetic youthful style. In their latest album, *Human Condition*, released in 2023, Sam further explores the subtle experiences of different life stages and uses music to accompany fans in facing life's challenges together.

Sam Yang has also accumulated extensive experience in stage plays and drama, with his diverse roles steadily enhancing his ability to interpret dramatic characters. In 2023, he won the Best Supporting Actor award (television series) at the 58th Golden Bell Awards for *I Do*.



CRYSTAL LINMingcan's daughter-in-law

Crystal Lin graduated from the Performing Arts Department (Music Division) of Hwa Kang Arts School. She debuted in 2008 through the singing competition show *One Million Star.* In 2012, she starred as Min-Min in the film *Din Tao*, which achieved remarkable box office success, grossing over 300 million NTD in Taiwan. In 2015, her performance in the Hakka TV drama *Long Day's Journey into Light* earned her a nomination for Best Supporting Actress (television series) at the 50th Golden Bell Awards.



FROGMingcan's grandson

18-year-old rapper and battle MC, Frog, is based in Tainan. He has been passionate about rap music since the second grade of elementary school, dedicating his free time to music every day. Despite his young age, he has earned a strong reputation in Tainan's underground rap scene and has dominated countless freestyle battle competitions.

WU NIEN-JENDirector / Playwright

Wu Nien-jen is a Taiwanese director, playwright, actor and writer, who was the first to win all four Golden Awards—the Golden Melody Award, Golden Bell Award, Golden Horse Award, and Golden Tripod Award. He is currently the chairman of Greenray Inc. His signature works include Daughter of the Nile, A Borrowed Life, Osmanthus Alley, A City of Sadness, and Dust in the Wind.

Wu joined the Greenray Theatre Company in 2001 and created the *Human Condition* series, which has been staged more than 400 times since. His works are reflections of the daily lives of everyday people, with plots that are simple and sincere, successfully attracting first-time theatre audiences.



DENNY WUExecutive Director

Denny Wu graduated from the Department of Drama at National Taiwan University and works in both acting and directing. He has appeared in television dramas such as *Iron Ladies* and *Island Nation*. He has also performed in and directed numerous stage productions for Greenray Theatre Company, Story Works, Spring River Performing Arts Troupe, and Tang Mei Yun Taiwanese Opera Company.

Lee Chun-yu is a professional lecturer in the Department of Theatre Arts at National Sun Yat-sen University, currently specialising in lighting design.

He has collaborated with Greenray Theatre Company, Hsu Ya-fen Taiwanese Opera Troupe, National Symphony Orchestra, Taipei Symphony Orchestra, Taipei Opera Theatre, Taipei Li-yuan Peking Opera Theatre, and Neo-Classic Dance Company, among others, totaling over 200 lighting design projects.

His stage design for *Human Condition III* was shortlisted for the 2009 World Stage Design Exhibition.

Nieh Ling graduated from the Department of Music, Fu Jen Catholic University and Berklee College of Music.

Her music design portfolio spans advertisements, film scores, classical music, and pop music. The crossover album Where the Songs Begin, featuring the ancient melodies of the Paiwan tribe sung by the Taiwu Ancient Ballads Troupe, was nominated for the 23rd Golden Melody

Awards for Traditional Arts and Music in the categories of Best Crossover Music Album, Best Album Producer, and Best Interpretation of Traditional Music, which the album ultimately won. Additionally, the original film score for *Twelve Nights* was nominated for Best Original Film Score at the 50th Golden Horse Awards.

Chen Wen Liang graduated from the Department of Theatre Design at Taipei National University of the Arts, majoring in costume design. Has been engaged in costume-related work for theatre, film, and television.

刚加入滨海艺术中心时,我很难向父母和亲戚形容自己的工作。由于我的英文职称为"Programmer",他们总以为我是一名信息技术程序员。这么多年来,只要有机会我都会带他们去观看演出,向他们解释我的工作。如今,我的亲戚们不仅参加华艺节,他们甚至比我还心急,想要第一时间知道节目安排!简单来说,举办这个艺术节的意义,就是能够将顶尖的演出和主题与不同观众群及他们的所愿或所需联系起来。从2025年2月7日至16日举行的第23届华艺节将一再彰显这文化艺术节的宗旨——让每个人都能参与其中,各有所好,各有所乐。

听故事谁不爱,而喜欢听精彩故事的你,今年就必须欣赏在滨海艺术中心剧院上演的两部作品。老舍于1930年代就写下了《骆驼祥子》的故事,放眼今天,岛上亦处处是现代人力车夫的身影——他们正骑着脚踏车去送外卖,努力工作谋生。继在中国巡演获得热烈反响后,获奖导演方旭将携一众演员实力呈现《骆驼祥子》。由著名台湾剧团绿光剧团带来的《人间条件八-凡人歌》中,主人公一直梦想着中彩票,这何尝不是许多平凡人的愿望呢?

人到晚年,应该如何保持活跃、不失活力?拥有友谊,或者缺乏 友谊会是什么样的一种状态?这些都是新加坡文化奖得主、资深编 舞家刘美玉的舞蹈作品《与我共舞》所探讨的主题。新加坡戏剧界的 常青树詹辉朕则以其编、导、演的独角戏《最后的午餐肉》,潜入 孤独的深海,审视形单影只的寂寞回响。 在人工智能即将席卷全球的时代,自得琴社《琴为何物·唐·孤烟直》、 不二击声音制造所《寄声之庙》,以及由滨海艺术中心与湘灵音乐 社和台湾导演李易修联合制作的《君·心:南洋梦昭君》,这三部引 人入胜的音乐作品将带领我们思考何为"传统"与"传承"。

每一位写歌的人都是一位生活的诗人。今年的"好in:: 乐"将是优秀唱作人集锦——台湾金曲奖得主、独立音乐歌者安溥;香港唱作歌手岑宁儿;台湾独立乐团"好乐团";以及新加坡创作才女文慧如。

想必很多小朋友们都很喜欢糖果、软糖和巧克力!台湾尝剧场的《山间有座糖果屋》改编自耳熟能详的童话故事《糖果屋》,趣味结合讲故事和拟声音效,有助孩子们锻炼中文听力,并接触多种不同的音效,激发他们的想象力。另外,以粤语脱口秀爆笑出圈的马来西亚艺人李欣怡,也将诚意献上狮城首秀,保证让你捧腹大笑。

除了推出能打动人心或让人乐开怀的各种作品外,华艺节力求为 "节目"赋予"节庆"之意。每年农历新年期间举办华艺节,使我们 得以祝愿前来滨海艺术中心参加活动的每一位观众在新的一年里 好运连连、身体健康、万事如意。作为艺术节的幕后制作人和策划 人,我们与观众同欢同庆贺新岁。

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
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




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
