Going to Esplanade



- You are going to a place called
 Esplanade Theatres on the Bay.
 Some people also call it Esplanade.
- You will be watching a performance at Esplanade. The title of the performance is A Drop in the Ocean.
- This is what Esplanade looks like.

Tickets



- Before you can watch the performance, you must buy a ticket to watch A Drop in the Ocean.
- Your grown up will be buying the ticket.
- The ticket will tell you information like
 - Where to go to watch the performance.
 - Date of the performance.
 - Time the performance is happening.
- This is what your e-ticket might look like.

Esplanade Recital Studio



- This is the Esplanade Recital Studio.
 There is a stage.
- A stage is a space where performances take place.
- The Esplanade Recital Studio is the venue for this performance.

Accessibility features for this performance



This is a Relaxed Performance


- You can move around and make noise during the performance.
- You can come and go as you need to. Re-entry is allowed.
- There is a Calm Space for you if you need a break from the performance.
- There will be an announcement that explains what a Relaxed Performance is.
- There will not be any strobe lights, sudden darkness or blackouts. If there are any, they will be listed in this Pre-Event Guide.
- The sound levels will remain the same with no loud or surprising noises. If there are any, they will be listed in this Pre-Event Guide.

Assistive Listening




- An Assistive Listening system is available for this venue.
- Hearing aid users with a Telecoil-enabled programme can benefit from the system provided.
- Please arrive at the venue 30 min before the performance.
- Please approach an usher at the venue and they can assist with the setup.

Calm Space



- If you or your child need to leave when the performance is happening to calm down, there is a Calm Space for you to use.
- The Calm Space is located at the foyer space behind Door 2 in the Recital Studio.

Calm Space



- You can only access Door 2 from inside the Recital Studio.
- You can return any time during the performance when your child is ready.
- If you need directions to the Calm Space, you can ask an usher for help.

Using the washroom



- If you need to use the washroom or change your child's diaper during the performance, an usher can direct you to the washroom or diaper changing station.
- You can return to watch the performance at any time.

A Drop in the Ocean



- A Drop in the Ocean takes place inside the Esplanade Recital Studio.
- There will be a 10-minute pre-show and post-show segment where you and your child can interact with the performers.
- You may take photos of your child during these times.
- Please do not take photos during the performance.

A Drop in the Ocean



- A Drop in the Ocean is an interactive and non-verbal sensory experience.
- You and your child will explore the wonders of the ocean through music, sounds and movement.
- The performance can get a little dark. Some lights will be turned on to help you and your child see.

Lights, music and haze



- You will get to see many different light effects.
- There will also be live music and sound effects played during the performance.
- There will be some haze effect used during the performance. This is safe for audiences.

Shoes off inside the Recital Studio



 When you enter the Recital Studio, you will have to take off your shoes before stepping onto the performance space.

Where can you sit?



- There will be round black cushions on the floor.
- You can choose a cushion to sit on with your child.
- An usher may help you and show you where you can sit.

Performers and props



- There will be 4 performers.
- The performers will be using large puppets and props made from rope and plastic.
- You and your child are welcome to touch the puppets and props gently.
- For you and your child's safety, please do not pull the hanging structures.

Movement and noise



- Your child can make noises or vocalise during the performance.
- They can also roll or crawl in the space.
- The performers will be mindful of them.
