Going to Esplanade



- You are going to a place called
 Esplanade Theatres on the Bay.
 Some people also call it Esplanade.
- This is what Esplanade looks like.
- You are going to watch a National Theatre Live screening.
- A National Theatre Live screening is like watching a movie. There will be a screen set up on stage.




- This is the Singtel Waterfront Theatre at Esplanade
- The Singtel Waterfront Theatre at Esplanade is the venue for this National Theatre Live screening.

Singtel Waterfront Theatre at Esplanade



- There are many seats in the Singtel Waterfront Theatre at Esplanade.
- A ticket is needed to watch the screening here.
- You may sit on any seat you like. An usher may also help with finding the right seat.



- Before you can watch the National Theatre Live screening, you must buy a ticket.
- The ticket will tell you information like
 - Where to go to watch the screening.
 - Date of the screening.
 - Time the screening is happening.
- This is what your e-ticket might look like.


Accessibility features for this screening



This is a **Relaxed Environment** screening

- Moving during the screening is alright. You can walk around or sit down while the screening is happening.
- If you need to use the washroom during the screening, that is alright. An usher can show the way to the washroom.
- After using the washroom, the usher can help you return to your seat.
- Sometimes, it may be necessary to leave the screening venue to find a quiet place to calm down. It is alright to return to the screening when you are ready.

Directions to the Calm Space



Singtel Waterfront Theatre Foyer, Level 1

- If you need some quiet or need to step away from the screening, you can go to the Calm Space.
- The Calm Space is at the Level 2 Foyer.
- You can ask an usher to show you the way to the Calm Space.
- If you are at the screening venue on Level 1, you can take the staircase or lift up to Level 2.

Directions to the Calm Space



Singtel Waterfront Theatre Foyer, Level 2

- If you are at the screening venue on Level 2, the Calm Space is located at the Foyer on Level 2.
- You can ask an usher to show you the way to the Calm Space.

Calm Space



- This is the Calm Space.
- You can rest on the chairs and use any of the items provided at the Calm Space if you need to.
- When you are ready, you can go back into the theatre to enjoy the rest of the screening.

Assistive Listening



- An Assistive Listening system is available for this venue.
- Hearing aid users with a Telecoil-enabled programme can benefit from the system provided.
- Please arrive at the venue 30 minutes before the screening.
- You can approach an usher at the venue and they can assist with the setup.

Information on the screening

National Theatre Live: Dr. Strangelove



- You are going to watch a film screening of a performance by the National Theatre from the UK.
- The cast is made up of actors.
- During the screening, you will see the actors perform different characters.
- The title of the screening is Dr. Strangelove. You can watch a video trailer <u>here</u>.

National Theatre Live: Dr. Strangelove



- This screening will be 2 hours and 30 minutes long. There will be a 20-minute break in between.
- This screening is rated PG13. This means that parental guidance is advised for persons under the age of 13.
- There is some coarse language and sexual references.

National Theatre Live: Dr. Strangelove



- This screening has scenes with flashing lights. This may affect people who are sensitive to flashing lights.
- If you do not feel good at any time, you can leave the venue for a while.
- When you are ready, you can go back into the theatre to enjoy the rest of the screening.
