

About Esplanade – Theatres on the Bay

Esplanade is Singapore's national performing arts centre. It hosts a year-round line-up of about 4,000 live performances and activities presented by Esplanade, its partners and hirers. As an arts centre for everyone, Esplanade also creates opportunities for seniors, youth, children and underserved communities to experience the arts. More than 70% of the shows that take place each year at the centre are free for all to enjoy.

Esplanade also brings the arts virtually to audiences in Singapore and beyond, through its diverse range of digital programmes on *Esplanade Offstage*, an all-access backstage pass to the performing arts and guide to Singapore and Asian arts and culture, with videos, podcasts, articles, quizzes and resources.

The centre works in close partnership with local, regional and international artists to develop artistic capabilities and content, push artistic boundaries and engage audiences. Esplanade supports the creation of artistic content by commissioning and producing new Singapore and Asian work for the international stage. It also develops technical capabilities for the industry nationally.

Esplanade – Theatres on the Bay is operated by The Esplanade Co Ltd (TECL), which is a not-for-profit organisation, a registered Charity and an Institution of a Public Character. TECL received the Charity Governance Award – Special Commendation for Clarity of Strategy in 2016 and 2022, the Charity Transparency Award from 2016 – 2023, and the Charity Transparency Dedication Award in 2024. Esplanade is Singapore's first Dementia-Friendly Arts Venue and a certified Dementia Go-To Point, as well as a guide/assistance dog friendly centre.

TECL receives funding support from Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth and its Community Programmes are supported by Tote Board Family, comprising Tote Board, Singapore Pools and Singapore Turf Club.

In a special tribute, we come together to celebrate **Datuk Habsah Hassan**, a beloved lyricist whose words have shaped some of the most well-loved songs in our region. *Dari Sudut Hati, Habsah Hassan* is a star-studded concert honouring her artistry, which has given voice to love, longing and joy across generations.

Beyond the ticketed programmes, don't miss the chance to experience *Pesta Raya*'s free programmes. This year, celebrate *dikir barat* group **Kelana Purba**'s 30th anniversary, enjoy pop hits from **Kaki Nyanyi**, alumni from Mediacorp's reality singing competition, and witness the grace and discipline of *silat* through performances around the centre. SYNOPSIS

In 1950s Kampung Kambing, Salina fights to survive the harsh realities of post-war Singapore—trapped in poverty, entangled in a toxic relationship, and forced by circumstance into work as an escort. Around her, a community of Malay and Indonesian migrants, once full of hope, now battle despair in a nation still reeling from the effects of World War II.

Adapted from the seminal novel by Malaysia's National Laureate A. Samad Said, *SAL/NA* is a gripping tale of resilience and survival, set against the backdrop of a community rebuilding itself. Drawing from his own childhood experiences under Japanese Occupation, A. Samad Said infuses his work with piercing realism, giving voice to the struggles of a generation through vivid characters and sharp, evocative dialogue.





DESCRIPTION OF MAIN CHARACTERS

SALINA

Salina loves to help those in need, even though her own life is filled with hardship. Living a life of ups and downs, she lost everything in World War II, including her family, her lover, and even her dignity. The economic situation after the war left Salina with no other choice but to work as a waitress in a bar, before eventually falling into prostitution. A victim of circumstance, Salina lives a life of sin but retains a noble heart, continuing to help those in need, especially her new neighbour, Khatijah, and her son, Hilmy.


HILMY

Hilmy is a young man driven by ambition. He lives with his ailing mother in his new home at Kampung Kambing. Having high hopes for his future, Hilmy's mother enrolled him in the English stream at Victoria School, despite it being a heavy burden to bear. However, due to the turmoil of a difficult life, his ambitions are cut short, just like his love for Nahidah.

NAHIDAH

After the death of her father, Nahidah is raised by a stepmother whose greed and selfishness define her upbringing. Small and powerless, she lives in a world that punishes vulnerability—enduring cruelty at home and later suffering further abuse at the hands of Abdul Fakar, who violates her. Her life is marked by injustice, shaped by those who use their power to harm rather than protect.

ABDUL FAKAR

Fakar is Salina's kept man who is shallow-minded, lazy, and entirely dependent on her. Offering nothing in return, he leeches off her generosity while indulging in a life of heavy drinking and reckless partying. Salina, convinced he is the reincarnation of her late lover, continues to support him despite his cruelty. When his desires are unmet, he turns violent, subjecting her to both physical and emotional abuse.

CAST BIOGRAPHY



Ariati Papar

(SALINA)

Ariati is an arts-loving individual whose journey began with Teater KAMi. After a hiatus, she returns to the stage, bringing with her decades of experience and a deep passion for performance. Since the '90s, she has built a rich body of work, moving effortlessly between emotionally intense roles and more understated characters—most notably her portrayal of a soft-spoken housewife in Channel 5's long-running drama *Kin*. Her nuanced performances have resonated with audiences and earned her numerous accolades over the years.



Fir Rahman

(ABDUL FAKAR)

Fir is a Singapore-based thespian who first rose to prominence in 2002, when he was crowned champion of a talent search on Mediacorp's Suria channel. Since then, he has built a distinguished career as a bilingual actor across television, theatre and film. His breakthrough came in Boo Junfeng's

award-winning feature *Apprentice* (2016), where his gripping performance as Aiman earned him a Best Newcomer nomination at the Asian Film Awards. He is also well known for his role as Reza in Mediacorp's long-form series *Lion Moms*. A lover of *teh tarik* and *asam pedas*, he dreams of one day acting alongside Al Pacino under the direction of Martin Scorsese.



Rizal Aiman (HILMY)

Rizal made his debut on Mediacorp's Suria channel in 2015 with the variety programme *Kolej Komedи*, and has since built a steady presence on television through dramas such as *Spy 2* and *Anak Metropolitan 4.0*. Beyond the screen, Rizal has been actively involved in theatre since 2017, bringing his versatility to the stage. In 2023, he received dual nominations for Best Actor in a Supporting Role at *Pesta Perdana*, recognising his performances in both a drama special and a drama series. Most recently, he starred in the 2024 Malay feature film *Salam Gembira*, earning praise for his compelling portrayal.



Amirah Yahya

(NAHIDAH)

Amirah is an actress with experience in television and stage productions, recognised for her compelling performances and versatility in portraying diverse characters. Her notable roles include Wati in *Tanglin*, Channel 5's long-running drama, and Hayatie in *Hayat Hayatie*, a stage production by Teater KAMi. She is excited to be back with Teater KAMi for this production of *SAL/NA* and is happy to be given the opportunity to refine her craft and expand her artistic repertoire.



Suhaila M Sanif

(KATIJAH)

Suhaila is a dedicated stage actor who began performing at the age of 18 and has since been actively involved in Singapore's theatre scene. Her journey began with Teater KAMi's youth production in 2002, and she has continued to bring compelling stories to life on stage. Passionate about her craft, she is committed to creating performances that move and resonate with audiences.



Rusydina Afiqah

CREATIVE & PRODUCTION TEAM BIOGRAPHIES



ATIN AMAT

Director / Playwright

Atin is a pioneer and important contributor to the development of Malay theatre in Singapore. She is currently the artistic director of Teater KAMi, a professional Malay theatre company she founded together with nine other practitioners on 5 June 1989. Through the years, Atin has worked with and guided many young practitioners, several of whom have continued to pursue professional theatre careers.

To date, Atin has directed more than 50 plays, including classic works adapted for the Malay context, such as *Ribut* (the Malay version of *Thunderstorm* by well-known China playwright Cao Yu), *Rashomon* (an adaptation of classic Japanese play) and *Perhiasan Kaca* (Tennessee Williams' *Glass Menagerie*). Atin also directed many plays based on the stories and lives of Malay people, such as *Nadra* (based on Maria Hertogh's story), *Munsyi* (based on the life

story of Munsyi Abdullah), *Lantai T Pinkie* (a play written by A. Samad Said) and *SALINA* (based on the celebrated novel by A. Samad Said), as well as plays inspired by the traditional Malay Opera, *bangsawan* such as *Indera Bangsawan* and *Pentas Opera*.

In 1999, Atin's company was struck by the Asian financial crisis. Nevertheless, Atin pressed on with her work in Malay theatre, immersing herself to reach out to the community and to groom the next generation of practitioners. She found inspiration in societal trends and happenings in the Malay community, and strove to make her plays accessible and relevant even for people with little background in the arts and theatre.

Atin's works are about the community and for the community which they can easily relate to in their everyday lives. This is seen in her works after the turn of the century, including *Mat Rock Minah Kental*, staged at Esplanade's *Pesta Raya 2004*, *Wira Bukit* (adapted from another of A. Samad Said's novels and staged at Esplanade in 2009), *Juma'at 6 Pagi* (a story of a death row inmate, staged at Esplanade in 2014) and plays on mental health issues like *NGACO* (2014) and *Naked* (2015). She also brought theatrical storytelling to young audiences across Singapore's heartlands with *Awang Batil* (2018).

Atin has proven herself to be a courageous leader of a theatre company, who has successfully navigated circumstantial constraints, continued her craft, and sustained an active engagement with young practitioners and the wider community. Even today, her seminal works from the late 1990s continue to resonate and remain relevant. Her contribution to the arts was recognised with the Cultural Medallion in 2011, awarded by Singapore's National Arts Council.



RAFEYAH A RAHMAN

Dramaturg

Rafeyah began her writing career in television in the 1990s, most notably contributing to the *Semarak Budaya* series. She went on to pen several well-loved programmes including *Sihat Oh Sihat*, *Zakat SG*, and *Warna Ramadan*.

As a playwright, Rafeyah has also written a number of stage works. Following her debut play *Geisha*, she wrote *Kisah Cinta Romzi dan Juleha*, which was staged at Esplanade in 2008. Her subsequent works include *Ayam Den Lapeh*, *Arba'a*, and *Senja Cruise*.

Teater KAM*i*

Teater KAM*i* was founded on 5th June 1989 by a group of enthusiastic young theatre practitioners who realised at a very early stage that theatre, as an art form is one of the most effective tools for education and social awareness towards a better life.

Teater KAM*i* turned professional in April 1997. By changing its status from society to “company limited”, Teater KAM*i*, again, created its own history by being the first and the only Malay professional theatre company in Singapore supported by the National Arts Council. In the same year, Teater KAM*i* became the first Malay/bilingual theatre company to represent not only Singapore but also its community as participants in the annual Cairo Experimental Theatre Festival. Teater KAM*i* celebrated its 10th anniversary in 1999, with a re-run of *Lantai T Pinkie* by A. Samad Said.

In 2001, Teater KAM*i* creatively converted their multi-purpose studio into a theatre space fit for productions in various performance formats, and named the space Teater KAM*i* Blackbox Studio. The company now prioritises theatre-making development, making full use of its existing facilities and minimising production costs by avoiding expensive theatre rentals.

Teater KAM*i* celebrated its 20th year anniversary in 2009 with a re-run of the popular play, *Wira Bukit* written by a Malaysian national literary treasure, A. Samad Said.

In 2012, Teater KAM*i* celebrated its 100th production since their founding, a fresh restaging, of *Balada Tun Fatimah*. In 2023, Teater KAM*i* celebrated 35 years in the arts industry.

To this end, Teater KAM*i* has proven to be a Malay theatre company, which has, and still is paving ways towards quality historical, social and educational artistic productions.

Teater KAM*i*'s philosophy is rooted in the belief that theatre, as an artistic practice, can and should serve as a platform for productions grounded in cultural and real-life education. They see theatre not only as a form of creative expression, but also as a meaningful tool for learning, reflection, and community engagement.

In line with this philosophy, their approach and objective centre on developing well-rounded theatre activists. Teater KAM*i* gives equal attention to both the internal and external aspects of performance training—fostering skills such as relaxation, focus, emotional engagement, and above all, imagination, alongside the external disciplines of speech, voice, and movement, which are essential in both theatre and real-life communication.

Teater KAM*i* usually produces three main productions annually. These productions are often showcased at Teater KAM*i*'s Black Box, Arts House Playden, Esplanade - Theatres on the Bay, Malay Heritage Centre, Substation and Drama Centre Black Box. Teater KAM*i* has received grants and donations from National Arts Council, Malay Language Learning & Promotion Committee, Malay Heritage Centre, Arts Fund, Lee Foundation, and Kean Im Thong Hood Cho Temple, just to name a few.

Besides theatre productions, Teater KAM*i* does outreach programmes such as workshops and school assembly programmes which are endorsed by the National Arts Council under the Arts Education Programme.

Artistic practice is a means of learning and real-life experience and there is nothing more valuable than being privileged to enjoy learning and be culturally aware in the present competitive environment.

Beliau meraih kejayaan menerusi filem *Boo Junfeng, Apprentice* (2016), di mana persembahannya yang mencengkam sebagai Aiman menjadikannya pencalonan Pelakon Baru Terbaik di Anugerah Filem Asia. Beliau juga terkenal dengan peranannya sebagai Reza dalam siri drama Mediacorp, *Lion Moms*. Pencinta teh tarik dan asam pedas, beliau mengimpikan untuk berlakon bersama Al Pacino pada suatu hari di bawah arahan Martin Scorsese.



Rizal Aiman

(HILMY)

Rizal mula tampil di saluran Mediacorp Suria pada 2015 dalam rancangan hiburan, *Kolej Komedi*, dan telah membina kehadirannya di televisyen menerusi drama seperti *Spy 2* dan *Anak Metropolitan 4.0*. Selain di televisyen, Rizal juga aktif dengan penglibatan dalam teater sejak 2017, menampilkan versatilitinya di atas pentas. Pada 2023, beliau menerima dua pencalonan bagi Pelakon Terbaik dalam Watak Sokongan di *Pesta Perdana*, mengiktiraf lakonannya dalam sebuah drama khas dan siri drama. Baru-baru ini, beliau tampil dalam filem cereka Melayu, *Salam Gembira*, mendapat pujian kerana penampilan menarik.



Amirah Yahya

(NAHIDAH)

Amirah merupakan seorang pelakon berpengalaman dalam penerbitan televisyen dan pentas, diiktiraf kerana persembahannya yang menarik dan serba boleh dalam membawakan pelbagai watak. Watak terkenalnya termasuk Wati dalam *Tanglin*, siri drama panjang di Saluran 5 Mediacorp, dan Hayatie dalam *Hayat Hayatie*, sebuah

(MANSUR)

(SAHAK)

Norisman telah menjalani pelbagai kehidupan di atas pentas sejak akhir 90-an sebagai pelakon, penari, pelawak solo, dan peniru watak. Lampu di pentas sentiasa terasa seperti rumahnya, dan persembahan adalah sifat keduanya. Hari ini, semangatnya masih membara seperti dahulu, dipacu oleh dorongan yang tidak pernah surut untuk berkembang menjadi seorang artis yang benar-benar prolifik dan serba boleh.



Andry Hrithik

(MOHSIN)

Andry adalah seorang pelakon berdedikasi dengan minat mendalam dalam persada teater Melayu. Mempunyai pengalaman melebihi sedekad di bawah bimbingan mentor yang dihormati seperti Encik Nadiputra dan Encik Roslan Daud, beliau bangga dengan krafnya. Selalu berkobar-kobar untuk berkembang, beliau kekal terbuka kepada peluang baru yang membolehkan beliau mempelajari dan membina sebagai seorang seniman. Beliau bakal memulakan pengajian Diploma dalam Pendidikan bagi Bahasa Melayu (peringkat darjah rendah), langkah yang didorong kerana cintanya terhadap

Bahasa Melayu. Beliau berharap dapat membawa ilmu yang diperolehi daripada diplomanya ke dalam karya teater pada masa depan.



Hazriq Idrus

(ENCIK SALIM)

Hazriq adalah seorang pelakon pentas yang berpangkalan di Singapura. Mula tampil dalam watak sokongan dalam pementasan *Indera Bangsawan* pada 1997 di Panggung Victoria bersama Teater KAMi, Hazriq sejak itu telah terlibat dalam pelbagai pementasan. Selain pementasan, Hazriq telah berlakon dalam televisyen, melakukan suara latar radio dan juga tampil dalam filem cereka.

Hazriq juga seorang jurulatih dalam pengkhususan komunikasi dan kepimpinan, menggunakan teknik teater, improvisasi sebagai alat untuk menyampaikan mesejnya. Beliau adalah pengarang *The Stage Fright Antidote!* dan *Creative Leadership*.



Fadhuli Fauzi

(MINDON)

Fadhuli berkembang pesat dalam penceritaan, irama dan rasa. Seorang penggemar teater, beliau bergerak dengan mudah di antara pentas, rentak ska dan padang bola sepak. Apabila tidak membuat persembahan, beliau berlari, memasak atau mencipta—sentiasa dengan penuh semangat.



Danial

(LEMAN)

Danial adalah seorang pelajar di Akademi Seni Halus Nanyang (NAFA), mempelajari Pembikinan Persembahan. Dengan semangat untuk meneroka pelbagai bidang, Danial komited untuk mengalami kehidupan sepenuhnya. Apabila tidak sibuk dengan pelajaran, beliau gemar mendaki dan berhubung dengan alam semula jadi. Pencapaian terbesarnya terletak pada mengejar apa yang memenuhi hatinya, kerana beliau percaya bahawa mengikuti keghairahan seseorang adalah kunci kepada kehidupan yang memuaskan.



Tajiyyah Sulwana Tajuddin

(ROSLINAH)

Tajiyyah iadalah seorang pendidik suara, penghibur dan pengkaji. Beliau kini sedang melakukan pengajian Sarjana Seni Halus dalam jurusan Pengajian Suara: Mengajar dan Membimbing di Sekolah Royal Central, Pertuturan dan Drama. Lulusan Akademi Seni Halus Nanyang, beliau mempunyai lulusan Sarjana Muda Kesenian (Kepujian Kelas Pertama) dalam Pembikinan Persembahan dan Diploma dalam Teater (Drama Inggeris) - Cemerlang. Tajiyyah baru-baru ini dianugerahkan Biasiswa Pasca Siswazah Lembaga Biasiswa Kenangan Maulud (LBKM) yang berprestij sebagai pengiktirafan terhadap komitmennya kepada seni dan pendidikan seni.



Decky 'Aishah

(BEDAH)

Decky adalah seorang artis yang perjalannya dalam seni persembahan bermula pada tahun 2007 sebagai seorang penari tradisional Melayu. Dari masa ke masa, minatnya berkembang dan beliau mula terlibat lebih dalam muzikal dan penerbitan teater. Karya teater terbarunya termasuk *AmaLia*, *Awang Batil* dan *Tepok Amai-Amai Belalang Kupu-Kupu*. Penglibatan

dan sumbangannya dalam bidang seni telah membolehkan beliau meneroka minatnya dengan lebih lanjut kerana beliau percaya setiap peluang yang diberikan adalah peluang untuk belajar dan menimba lebih banyak pengetahuan.



Haziqah Hashir

(MADHUBALA)

Haziqah adalah seorang pelakon televisyen di mana persembahannya telah memperolehi pencalonan bagi Pelakon Harapan Wanita di Pesta Perdana pada 2021 dan 2023. Bersyukur dengan setiap peluang, beliau telah menerima pelbagai peranan yang telah mengeratkan hubungannya dengan penonton. Ini penampilan sulung teaternya, Haziqah tidak sabar untuk menyahut cabaran baru, bersemangat untuk berlakon di atas pentas sambil kekal dalam perjalanan perkembangan artistiknya.



Rani Senari

(MAKCIK LEHA)

Pengembaran teater Rani bermula dengan Teater KAMi, di mana beliau membuat persembahan di perhimpunan sekolah dan bengkel sekolah, dan menjadikan pentas sebagai cinta sepanjang hayat untuk membuat persembahan. Beliau kemudian beralih ke dunia yang sama sekali berbeza di Singapore Turf Club, merangkul minatnya untuk menunggang kuda. Sepanjang perjalanan, beliau membina perniagaan e-dagang dan lulus dari universiti. Selepas berehat selama 25 tahun sejak persembahan terakhirnya dalam *Lantai T. Pinkie* pada 1999, Rani teruja untuk kembali ke pentas. Kali ini, beliau mengimbangi kegairahannya dengan kerja hariannya, bersedia untuk membawa tenaganya ke teater sekali lagi.



Fatin Shafura

(MUNAH)

Fatin adalah peminat teater yang bersemangat ingin tahu tentang setiap aspek pentas. Daripada berlakon dan menyanyi hingga ke penerbitan di belakang tabir, beliau menerima setiap peranan sebagai peluang untuk belajar dan berkembang. Didorong oleh kecintaannya terhadap seni, Fatin berkembang maju dengan mencabar sempadan kreatif dan

mendapati kebahagian dalam kedua-dua persembahan dan belakang tabir. Beliau menghargai setiap projek sebagai pengalaman unik dan sentiasa bersemangat untuk bekerjasama, menyahut cabaran baharu dan mendedahkan bakat baharu. Dengan setiap peluang, beliau komited untuk memberi yang terbaik di pentas.



Chariska Diva Anugrah (ZAINON)

Chariska adalah seorang penyanyi dan pelakon yang mempunyai pengalaman sedekad dalam teater. Perjalanan seniaya bermula pada usia 11 tahun, beliau telah bekerjasama di bawah penggiat teater yang disegani seperti Ross Nasir, Anwar Hadi, dan Marina Yusoff. Beliau baru-baru ini menerima anugerah Karya Seni Asli Terbaik dalam Pengarahan bagi penerbitan teater Melayu 2024, *Pelita*, bagi Pentas Budaya Universiti Nasional Singapura (NUS). Beliau kini sedang menjalani latihan bersama The Young Company dari Singapore Repertory Theatre dan sedang melanjutkan pengajian Sarjana Muda dalam Pentadbiran Perniagaan di Universiti Nasional Singapura.



Shiqah Sukri (MAKCIK TUMINAH)

Shiqah memulakan perjalannya dalam teater dengan kumpulan teater Melayu di Politeknik Temasek, Titisan, pada 2014, satu pengalaman yang mendalamkan semangatnya untuk berlakon dan mengesahkan komitmennya terhadap kraf tersebut. Pada 2016, beliau menamatkan bengkel Tumpil Yang Tampil (TYT) 2.0 anjuran Teater KAMi, di mana mereka memperhalusi kemahiran mereka dan meluaskan perspektif artistik mereka. Dengan pengalaman dalam kedua-dua peranan persembahan dan teknikal, Shiqah membawa pendekatan yang serba lengkap dan serba boleh kepada teater, dan tetap berdedikasi untuk menyumbang secara bermakna kepada komuniti seni tempatan.



Firuz Khan (BHAI SARABAT)

Penglibatan Firuz dalam bidang lakonan muncul secara tidak sengaja. Beliau telah menemani rakannya untuk sesi uji bakat bagi pertandingan lakonan dan membuat keputusan untuk mencubanya juga. Beliau akhirnya menjadi salah seorang finalis dan kemudian diberi peluang untuk berlakon di televisyen dan di pentas. Beliau berehat daripada penglibatannya dalam industri hiburan untuk menjaga ibunya pada tahun

2020. Tahun ini, beliau kembali untuk mencubanya sekali lagi. Selain berlakon, Firuz juga berpengalaman dalam bidang pengacaraan dan nyanyian, di mana beliau menceburi kedua-duanya sebagai kerja sampingan.

Khairuzamani Md Noor (KOMENG)

Khairuzamani—dikenali rakan dan keluarganya sebagai Khai atau Zamani—adalah seorang usahawan yang memilik perniagaan percetakannya sendiri. Di luar pekerjaan, beliau amat meminati aktiviti kebudayaan dan seni persembahan, khususnya dikir barat, muzik dan tarian Melayu tradisional. Seorang pengamal silat yang mahir dan pemain pelbagai instrumen, Khai bermain gitar, trompet dan piano.

Apabila beliau tidak bekerja atau membuat persembahan, beliau menikmati masa berkualiti bersama keluarga dan menemui tempat baharu melalui pengembalaan. Keperibadiannya yang mesra dan minatnya yang luas menjadikannya beliau senang didekati.



Muhammad Khairi

(BULAT)

Khairi adalah seorang kanak-kanak 10 tahun yang ceria dan pintar yang selalu tersenyum. Beliau merupakan seorang kanak-kanak peramah yang cemerlang dalam seni persembahan (drama dan tarian), silat dan sukan bola sepak. Cerdas dan boleh berjenaka, Khairi membawa kegembiraan kepada orang di sekelilingnya. Beliau rendah diri, menghormati, dan sentiasa menunjukkan kebaikan kepada orang lain. Sangat senang bersamanya!

BIOGRAFI TENAGA KERJA KREATIF & PRODUKSI



ATIN AMAT

Director / Playwright

Seorang perintis dan penggerak penting kepada perkembangan teater Melayu di Singapura. Beliau kini merupakan pengarah artistik Teater KAMi, sebuah syarikat teater Melayu profesional yang diasaskannya bersama sembilan pengamal lain pada 5 Jun 1989. Bertahun-tahun, Atin telah bekerja dengan dan membimbing ramai pengamal teater muda, beberapa daripadanya terus meneruskan kerjaya teater profesional.

Sehingga kini, Atin telah mengarahkan lebih daripada 50 pementasan, termasuk karya klasik yang diadaptasi untuk konteks Melayu, seperti Ribut (versi Melayu Ribut Petir oleh penulis drama terkenal China Cao Yu), Rashomon (adaptasi drama klasik Jepun) dan Perhiasan Kaca (Tennessee Williams' Glass Menagerie). Atin juga mengarah banyak persembahan teater berdasarkan kisah dan kehidupan orang Melayu, seperti Nadra (berdasarkan kisah Maria Hertogh), Munsyi (berdasarkan kisah

hidup Munsyi Abdullah), Lantai T Pinkie (naskhah pentas yang ditulis oleh A. Samad Said) dan Salina (pementasan novel terkenal A. Samad Said), serta pementasan yang diinspirasikan dar Bangsawan seperti Indera Bangsawan dan Pentas Opera.

Pada 1999, syarikat Atin telah dilanda krisis kewangan Asia. Namun begitu, Atin meneruskan kerjanya dalam teater Melayu, menyelami diri untuk mendekati masyarakat dan membentuk generasi pengamal teater seterusnya. Dia mendapat inspirasi dalam tren dan keadaan masyarakat Melayu, dan berusaha untuk menjadikan karyanya mudah diterima dan relevan untuk mereka yang belum didedahkan kepada seni teater.

Karya-karya Atin adalah tentang masyarakat dan untuk masyarakat di mana mereka boleh kaitkan dengan mudah dalam kehidupan seharian mereka. Ini dilihat dalam karya-karyanya seperti Mat Rock Minah Kental (Pesta Raya Esplanade 2004), Wira Bukit (satu lagi novel terkenal A. Samad Said di Esplanade, 2009), Juma'at 6 Pagi (kisah banduan dihukum mati di Esplanade, 2014) dan memainkan isu kesihatan mental seperti Ngaco (2014) dan *Naked* (2014). Dan merentasi Singapura dengan produksi teater cerita rakyat untuk kanak-kanak – Awang Batil (2018).

Sememangnya, Atin telah membuktikan dirinya sebagai pemimpin berani sebuah syarikat teater, yang telah berjaya mengharungi kekangan keadaan, meneruskan hasil kerjanya, dan mengekalkan penglibatan aktif dengan pengamal teater muda dan masyarakat. Sehingga hari ini, karya-karya besar beliau dari akhir 1990-an terus bergema. Sumbangan beliau kepada seni telah diiktiraf dengan Pingat Budaya pada 2011, dianugerahkan oleh Majlis Seni Kebangsaan Singapura..



RAFEYAH A RAHMAN

Dramaturg

Rafeyah mulakan kerjaya penulisannya di televisyen pada 1990-an, dengan karya utamanya, siri *Semarak Budaya*. Beliau kemudian menulis beberapa program yang digemari ramai termasuk *Sihat Oh Sihat*, *Zakat SG*, dan *Warna Ramadan*.

Sebagai penulis drama, Rafeyah juga telah menulis beberapa karya pentas. Menyusuli pementasan sulungnya, *Geisha*, beliau menulis *Kisah Cinta Romzi dan Juleha*, yang dipentaskan di Esplanade pada tahun 2008. Karya berikutnya termasuk *Ayam Den Lapeh*, *Arba'a*, dan *Senja Cruise*.

SHAFEI

Penasihat Teknikal Produksi



Shafei adalah seorang Penasihat Teknikal di Teater KAMi, di mana beliau menyokong penerbitan teater dengan melihat aspek teknikal seperti rekaan pentas, pencahayaan dan bunyi. Peranannya melibatkan penyampaian persembahan yang lancar menerusi penyelesaian teknikal dan koordinasi berkesan.



NORISHAM OSMAN

Pengurus Pentas & Produksi

Norisham adalah seorang daya kreatif yang dinamik, menggabungkan tradisi dan inovasi dalam tarian dan persembahan. Dengan latar belakang yang pelbagai yang merangkumi bentuk tarian tradisional dan kontemporer, perjalanan Norisham membuktikan kuasa transformatif pergerakan.

Sebagai pengasas dan pengarah artistik The Kaizen M.D. (Multidisiplinari) Collective, Norisham mengetuai penerokaan terhadap kemungkinan naratif merentasi disiplin. Karya beliau meraikan kekayaan warisan tarian sambil mencabar sempadan ekspresi artistik.

Falsafah seni Norisham memberi tumpuan terhadap menghormati masa lalu sambil memeluk masa kini dan masa depan. Beliau percaya tentang kepentingan menghubungkan tradisi sebagai sumber inspirasi, tetapi tidak gentar untuk mencabar konvensyen dan membuka laluan baharu ke hadapan.



FADLIN FALADINO

Pengurus Teknikal/Pereka Pencahayaan

Fadlin adalah seorang juruteknik teater profesional yang aktif dan serba boleh, dengan pengalaman dalam pelbagai peranan seperti pengarah, penulis skrip, penghibur, pengurusan dan operasi teknikal, jurulatih dan fasilitator. Kekuatan utama beliau kini adalah dalam reka bentuk sistem AV, AV digital dan rangkaian, kejuruteraan audio, reka bentuk dan operasi pencahayaan, reka bentuk visual dan multimedia, serta pengurusan pentas dan teater teknikal. Sifat versatil dengan sikap tidak pernah berkata tidak, dan pengalaman luas dalam pengurusan teater teknikal di pelbagai tempat seni telah memberi manfaat kepada banyak penerbitan yang telah diusahakannya.



DAN AHMAD

Pereka Bunyi

Dan mempunyai minat mendalam terhadap bunyi, muzik, audio dan seni persembahan. Seorang pereka bunyi yang mengamalkan merentas disiplin seni yang berbeza, beliau menggabungkan manipulasi bunyi dengan penceritaan, meneroka selok-belok sonik dalam semua karyanya.



YAN ASAN

Ketua Seni Pemandangan / Pakar Prop

Yan adalah seorang artis seni halus dan pereka set dan persekitaran untuk teater dan produksi kanak-kanak. Dilatih dalam Seni Halus (Lukisan), beliau membawa kepekaan pelukis kepada kerja reka bentuknya, memfokuskan pada membentuk pengalaman penonton sambil menyokong visi pengarah. Proses kreatifnya bermula dengan pemahaman mendalam tentang niat pengarah, diikuti dengan penerokaan konsep ruang dan penceritaan visual yang menyeronokkan. Setiap penerbitan baru mempersempahkan kanvas baharu—peluang untuk membayangkan yang baharu, dan sifat penerbitan yang sentiasa berubah ini terus memberi inspirasi kepadanya. Yan telah bekerja di teater kanak-kanak selama melebihi lima tahun di The Little Arts Academy, dan kemudiannya dengan Teater KAM*i*.



AFI HASHIM

Seni Pemandangan / Penolong Pakar Prop

Afi adalah seorang pembantu fabrikasi set, artis visual dan penyelidik yang meneroka persimpangan cerita rakyat, memori budaya dan penceritaan ruang. Dengan latar belakang dalam seni halus dan penerbitan teater, latihannya merangkumi lukisan pemandangan, pemasangan media campuran dan fabrikasi prop. Beliau bekerjasama rapat dengan pasukan penerbitan untuk menghidupkan visi kreatif, mencipta persekitaran yang mengasyikkan yang meningkatkan naratif teater dan pengalaman penonton. Ghairah tentang cara naratif berkembang dari semasa ke semasa, karya Afi mentafsir semula kisah tradisional dalam ruang kontemporari, merapatkan warisan dan kemodenan melalui penceritaan visual.

RAFIL K.

Ketua, Busana dan Tatarias



Rafil dikenali dalam persada seni dan media Singapura dengan kerja meluasnya sebagai penggaya imej selebriti dan jurusolek. Beliau telah menjadi sebahagian daripada Teater KAM/i sejak 2010, memberi khidmat seni solekannya untuk pelbagai produksi. Perjalanan kreatifnya telah berkembang ke Teater Ekamatra, di

mana beliau terus membentuk dan memperkayakan naratif budaya Singapura. Sebelum ini, beliau berkhidmat sebagai Ketua Busana untuk dua penerbitan utama Teater Ekamatra: Bangsawan Gemala Malam (2022) dan Bawang Putih Bawang Merah yang dipentaskan di *Pesta Raya 2024* di Esplanade.



DALIFAH SHAHRIL

Penerbit Eksekutif

Seorang pelakon dan pendidik drama dwibahasa dalam bahasa Inggeris dan Melayu. Beliau juga seorang pelakon dan bakat suara untuk pelbagai syarikat dan penerbitan televisyen. Lulusan Institut Pendidikan Nasional (Pendidikan Seni), Dalifah gemar bekerja dengan kanak-kanak kecil dan mengajar pertuturan dan drama di sekolah-sekolah Kementerian Pendidikan. Dalifah dinobatkan sebagai Pelakon Wanita Terbaik di Anugerah Teater Straits Times Life! 2018 dan dicalonkan untuk kategori yang sama pada 2019 untuk *Lanang* oleh Hatch Theatrics. Beliau merupakan pentadbir utama dan artis residen Teater KAMi.



SAIFUL AMRI AHMAD ELAHI

Penerbit Eksekutif

Saiful adalah seorang penggiat teater yang telah memenangi pelbagai anugerah dan telah menyahut panggilan untuk menjadi Penerbit Kreatif dalam persada seni persembahan Melayu Singapura. Hari ini, beliau merupakan seorang penggerak bebas yang menguruskan projek seni, budaya dan warisan aneka genre, dan terlibat dalam teater sebagai penerbit, pengarah, pengurus, penulis dan pelakon. Beliau kini berada di panel penilaian untuk Seni Jalanan (Busking) Majlis Seni Kebangsaan dan Persembahan Drama untuk Festival Seni Belia Singapura kelolaan Kementerian Pendidikan.

Teater KAM*i*

Teater KAM*i* ditubuhkan pada 5 Jun 1989 oleh sekumpulan penggiat teater muda yang berjiwa besar. Mereka sedar pada peringkat awal bahawa teater sebagai bentuk seni adalah alat paling berkesan untuk pendidikan dan kesedaran sosial terhadap kehidupan yang lebih baik.

Teater KAM*i* menjadi sebuah syarikat profesional pada April 1997. Dengan menukar status daripada Persatuan kepada "Syarikat Terhad", Teater KAM*i*, sekali lagi, mencipta sejarah tersendiri dengan menjadi satu-satunya syarikat teater profesional Melayu yang disokong oleh Majlis Seni Kebangsaan. Pada tahun yang sama, Teater Kami menjadi syarikat teater dwibahasa/Melayu pertama untuk mewakili, bukan sahaja Singapura tetapi juga masyarakatnya dalam Festival Teater Eksperimental Cairo yang dianjurkan secara tahunan. Teater Kami meraikan ulangtahun ke-10 pada 1999, dengan pementasan semula karya, Lantai T Pinkie oleh A. Samad Said.

Pada 2001, Teater KAM*i* secara kreatif mengubah studio serbaguna mereka menjadi sebuah ruang teater, sesuai untuk produksi dalam pelbagai format persembahan, dan menamakan ruang itu sebagai Teater KAM*i* Blackbox Studio. Dan kini mengutamakan pembangunan pembikinan teater, menggunakan sepenuhnya kemudahan sedia ada

dan mengurangkan kos produksi dengan mengelak sewa ruang teater yang mahal.

Teater KAM*i* meraikan ulang tahun ke-20 tahunnya pada 2009 dengan pementasan semula karya popular, *Wira Bukit*, sebuah lagi khazanah tulisan sasterawan negara, A. Samad Said.

Pada 2012, Teater KAM*i* meraikan pementasan yang ke-100 sejak ia ditubuhkan dengan pementasan *Balada Tun Fatimah*, yang dikemaskini. Pada 2023, Teater Kami menyambut ulang tahun yang ke-35 tahun dalam industri seni.

Teater KAM*i* telah terbukti sebagai sebuah syarikat teater Melayu, yang telah, dan masih membuka jalan ke arah penerbitan seni sejarah, sosial dan pendidikan yang berkualiti.

Akar falsafah Teater KAM*i* adalah kepercayaan bahawa teater, sebagai amalan seni, boleh dan harus berfungsi sebagai wadah bagi pementasan yang berasaskan budaya dan pendidikan kehidupan sebenar. Mereka melihat teater, bukan sahaja sebagai satu bentuk ekspresi kreatif, tetapi juga sebagai alat yang bermakna untuk pembelajaran, refleksi dan penglibatan masyarakat.

Selaras dengan falsafah ini, pendekatan dan objektif mereka tertumpu kepada pembangunan aktivis teater serba boleh. Teater KAM*i* memberikan perhatian yang

sama kepada dua aspek latihan persembahan dalaman dan luaran - memupuk kemahiran seperti ketenangan, fokus, emosi, dan yang paling penting, imaginasi, di samping disiplin luaran berkenaan pertuturan, suara dan pergerakan. 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

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


