Accessibility features



This performance is a **Relaxed Environment** performance.

The letters RE indicate that you will be watching a Relaxed Environment performance.

Everyone experiences the arts differently. In a Relaxed Environment performance, you can:

- Move around and make some sounds if you need to.
- Exit the performance venue whenever you need to.
- Re-enter the performance venue at suitable pauses. An Esplanade usher will let you know when it is alright to re-enter the venue.
- We ask everyone to be understanding and supportive of others.

Accessibility features (continued)



There is a **Calm Space** available for use if you need a quieter place.

The Calm Space is a quiet place to rest.

You may exit the Calm Space whenever you are ready to return to the performance venue.



The Calm Space is at The Bay Room.

The Bay Room is at Level 2 of the Esplanade Concert Hall.

Directions to the Calm Space at the Concert Hall (for Level 1 patrons)

If you are seated at Level 1, please read on for the directions to the Calm Space.



To get to the Calm Space, you have to:


- Leave the Concert Hall.
- Take the staircase up to Level 2.



If help is needed, an Esplanade Usher can show the way.

Directions to the Calm Space at the Concert Hall (for Level 3 patrons)

If you are seated at Level 3, please read on for the directions to the Calm Space.



To get to the Calm Space, you have to:

- Leave the Concert Hall.
- Take the staircase down to Level 2.



If help is needed, an Esplanade Usher can show the way.


Directions to the Calm Space at the Concert Hall (for Level 4 patrons)

If you are seated at Level 4, please read on for the directions to the Calm Space.



To get to the Calm Space, you have to:

- Leave the Concert Hall.
- Take the staircase down to Level 3.



Take the staircase down again to Level 2.



If help is needed, an Esplanade Usher can show the way.

Directions to the Calm Space at the Concert Hall (continued)



At Level 2, you should see glass windows on the right.



Walk straight to the end of the corridor to find The Bay Room.



The Bay Room is where the Calm Space is.

Accessibility features (continued)



An **Assistive Listening** system is available for this performance venue.



Hearing aid users with a Telecoil-enabled programme can benefit from the system provided.



An Esplanade Usher will assist you with the set-up of the system.

To utilise this system, please:

- Arrive 30mins before the performance.
- Approach an Esplanade Usher at the venue upon arrival.

About the performance venue



You will be watching the performance at **Esplanade – Theatres on the Bay**. Some people also call it Esplanade.



You will be watching the performance at the Esplanade Concert Hall.

Before the performance



Before you can watch the performance, you must buy a ticket.

The ticket will tell you information like:

- Where to go to watch the performance.
- Date of the performance.
- Time the performance is happening.
- Seat number.



There are many seats in the Concert Hall. It is important to sit in the assigned seat.



An Esplanade Usher may also help with finding the right seat.



If you have a bag, a security officer will check your bag.

Before the performance




You are welcome to come dressed as your favourite superhero if you like.



You may arrive up to 45 minutes before the show begins.

There will be a craft activity before the concert.

During the activity, you can make a shaker to create sounds with during the concert.



You will receive a programme booklet.

The programme booklet has information about what you will see at the concert.

There are also some fun activities that you can try at home after the concert which is written in the programme booklet.

About the performance



This concert is about a dinosaur in the Esplanade Concert Hall.

The dinosaur is lost.

You will see a dinosaur on stage.

It is not a real dinosaur.

It is a person wearing a dinosaur costume.



A group of music heroes called The Pitch Patrol comes to help the dinosaur find its way home.

The Pitch Patrol will wear costumes such as colourful capes.

About the performance



On their adventures, the Pitch Patrol meets other characters like a unicorn and merman.

These are actors wearing costumes.

The Pitch Patrol uses music to help these characters solve their problems.

During the performance



There will be stage lights during the performance.

The lights may change colours.

Sometimes, the lights may be brighter or darker.



If the lights make you uncomfortable, you may step out of the Concert Hall or go to the Calm Space.

That is okay.

You can return to the Concert Hall when you are ready.

During the performance

	<p>The actors and musicians will play music on stage.</p> <p>You will see different instruments like:</p>
	<p>The keytar</p>
	<p>The violin</p>
	<p>The flute</p>
	<p>The bass guitar</p>
	<p>Different types of drums</p>

During the performance



You may clap, move along and enjoy the music during the concert.



Sometimes, the music may be loud and energetic.

If the music gets too loud, you may step out of the Concert Hall or go to the Calm Space.

That is okay.

You can return to the Concert Hall when you are ready.

After the performance



The lights will turn on after the performance ends.

The Concert Hall will be bright again.

People will leave the theatre when the performance is over.

You can leave with your grown-up.


The Concert Hall might get crowded.
