



## EPISODE 1: HOW TO LISTEN. LIKE REALLY. REALLY LISTEN TO JAZZ

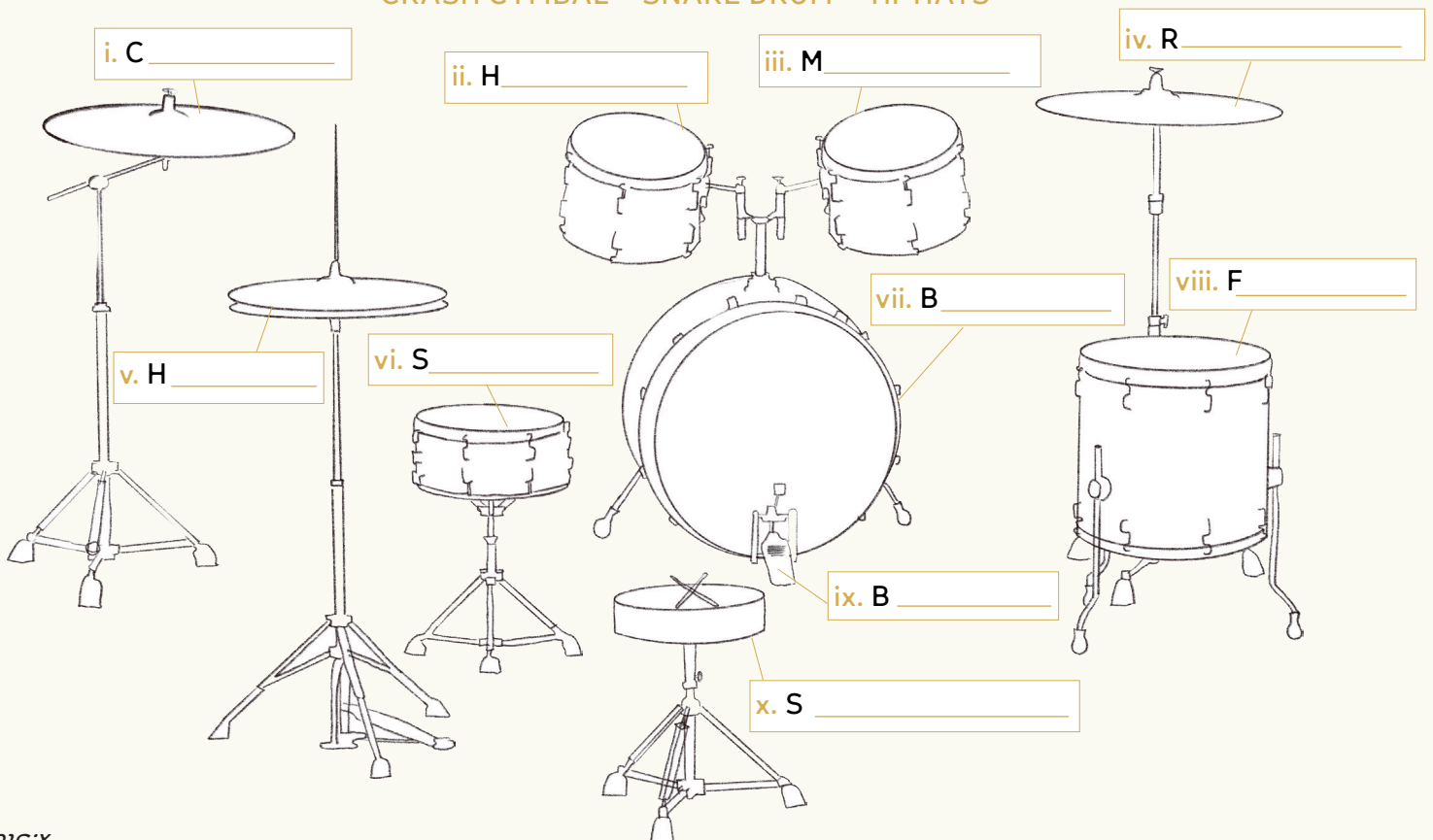
### 1. STAYING IN THE POCKET

In jazz, musicians play around with time, pushing and pulling to fit their intricate melodies. This helps to create the sense of tension and release we hear and feel throughout the jazz performance.

While mastery of rhythm and time-feel could take a musician their entire lifetime, it is essential to understand the foundation of rhythm, especially as it relates to the drums.

### JOSHUA WAN

#### PIANO AND KEYBOARDS

Joshua Wan is most recently known as the songwriter for the 2020 National Day Song, Everything I Am, sung by Nathan Hartono. Lesser known is his involvement with some of the biggest pop stars from the region and that he has been active in the local and regional music scene since the 90s!

Over the decades, Wan has performed artists like Tanya Chua, Dick Lee, Sandy Lam, Mavis Hee etc.





## TAMAGOH

### DRUMS

Tamagoh has been performing alongside Singapore's "King of Swing", Jeremy Monteiro since the 80s. Throughout his career, he has been highly regarded as one of the most popular session musicians (a musician who records in the studio). Some International names he has performed with include Ronan Keating, Frances Yip, Sarah Brightman and Coco Lee.



## SEBASTIAN HO

### GUITAR

Sebastian Ho is known as one of the most versatile musicians in Singapore, crossing genres from rock to pop, jazz to musical theatre. This has led him to be involved both in live shows as well as studio sessions for a multitude of artists in various different contexts, whether it is duo, trio or big band. Artists that Ho has performed with include Stefanie Sun, Laura Fygi, Kit Chan, Siti Nurhaliza and Singapore's "Papa Rock", Ramli Sarip.



## BEN POH

### BASS

The youngest in this pool of musicians, Ben Poh has already established himself as the first-call bassist for both local and regional artists, having performed at various music festivals.

Among others, Ben has performed recently with Jeremy Monteiro, Joanna Dong, Nathan Hartono and Kit Chan.
