


MAKE A TABLETOP PUPPET THEATRE STAGE

WHAT YOU'LL NEED


- A used cereal box
- Sticky tape
- Construction paper, or any coloured paper. You can also make do with white paper
- Glue
- Penknife, scissors
- A grown-up if you need a helping hand handling sharp objects.

INSTRUCTIONS


- 1 Get a used cereal box and tape down the flaps at the side.




- 2 Glue a piece of construction paper to one side of the used cereal box. Black preferred, but any colour works!




- 3 Use a penknife to cut a rectangle from the side of the cereal box with the black construction paper. Leave a 2-3cm border all around. **Get the help of a grown-up if you need to.**




- 4 Take another piece of construction paper and glue it to the inside of the box. This will be your theatre stage background.




- 5 Use a penknife to cut out a rectangle off the top of your cereal box. Leave a thin border around it.






- 6 If you want, you can decorate your theatre stage with the drapes provided. Glue the drapes onto the box. There you go! You have a tabletop puppet theatre stage!
