MAKE THESE PUPPETS FOR YOUR TABLETOP PUPPET THEATRE STAGE




WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Puppet template
- Colouring material
- Scissors
- Chopsticks
- Sticky tape or hot glue gun
- Blu-tack (optional)



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Print the puppet templates. You can print as many as you want.
- 2 Choose the characters that will appear in your story.
- 3 Colour into the puppets. There are blank puppets for you to draw in your own characters.
- 4 Cut out the puppets.
- 5 Flip the puppets so that the back part of the puppets face you. Use a chopstick and tape/glue it onto the head of your puppet. Make sure it is taped/glued down securely.



OPTIONAL

You can use the background scenery template provided to change the setting of the scene. Create a city scene or a kampong scene. You can even create your own background scenery. The sky is the limit.


Just tape the background inside the box and use Blu-tack to secure it. Voila! Your own tabletop puppet theatre stage and puppets, waiting for you to write a scene for them.




