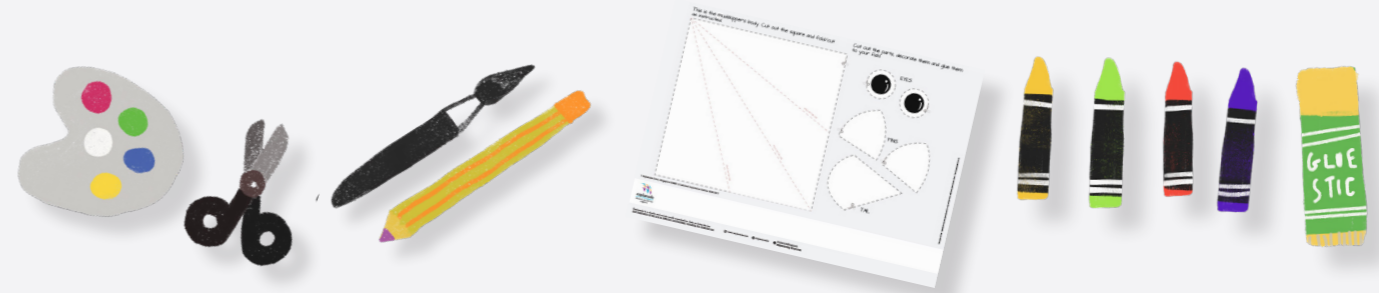


CRAFT YOUR OWN MUDSKIPPER!

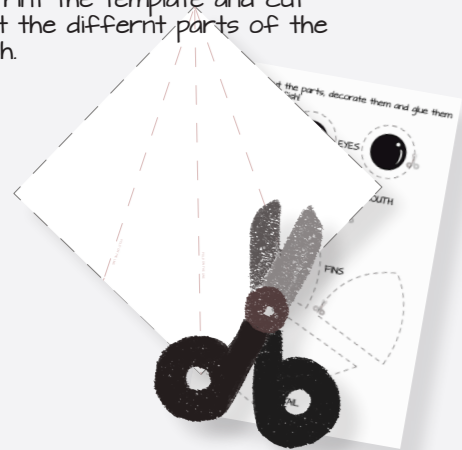
MATERIALS:

1. Printed template
2. Colouring material
3. Scissors
4. Glue

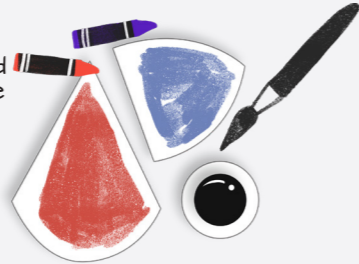


INSTRUCTIONS:

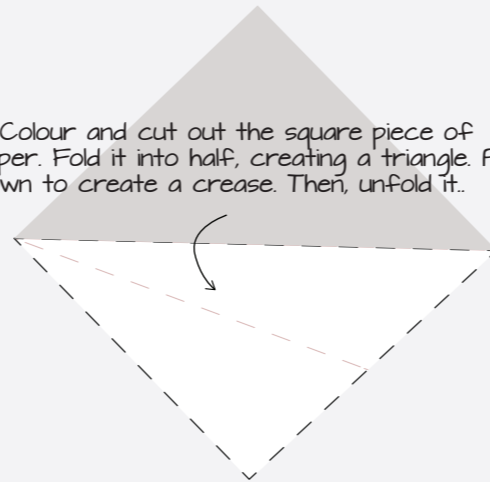
1. Print the template and cut out the different parts of the fish.



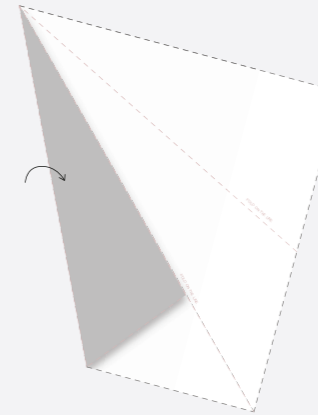
2. Colour and decorate the parts.



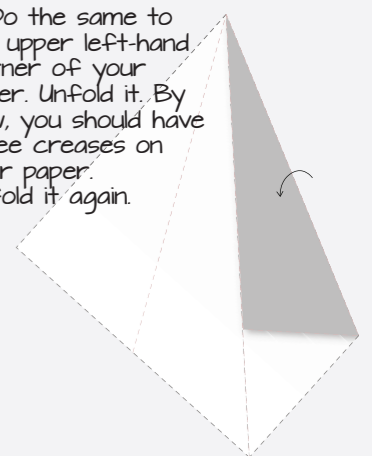
3. Colour and cut out the square piece of paper. Fold it into half, creating a triangle. Press down to create a crease. Then, unfold it.



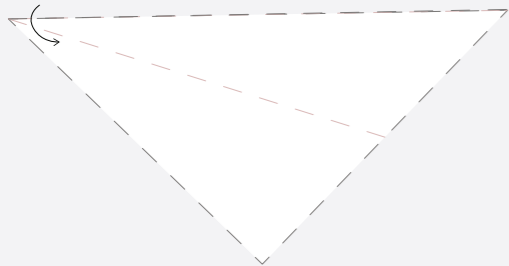
4. Fold in the bottom right hand corner towards the middle crease, creating another smaller triangle. Press down hard again to create a crease. You can follow the dotted fold lines given in the template as a guide. Unfold it again.



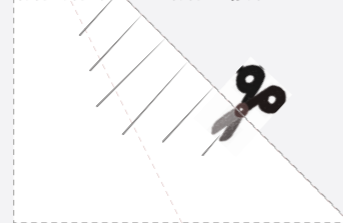
5. Do the same to the upper left-hand corner of your paper. Unfold it. By now, you should have three creases on your paper. Unfold it again.



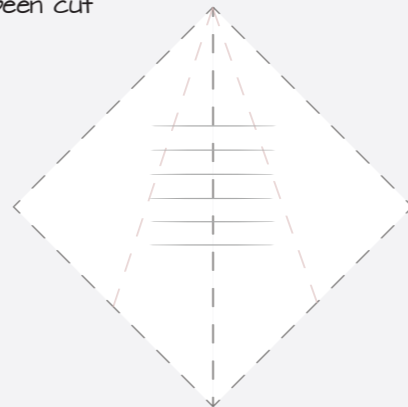
6. Now, fold the paper in half again, along the same crease created by the first fold.



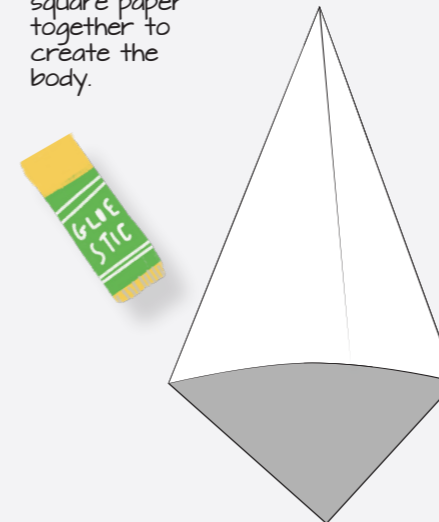
7. Make cuts along the folded edge towards the crease, about 2cm apart. Leave about 6-7cm at one end for the head of the fish.



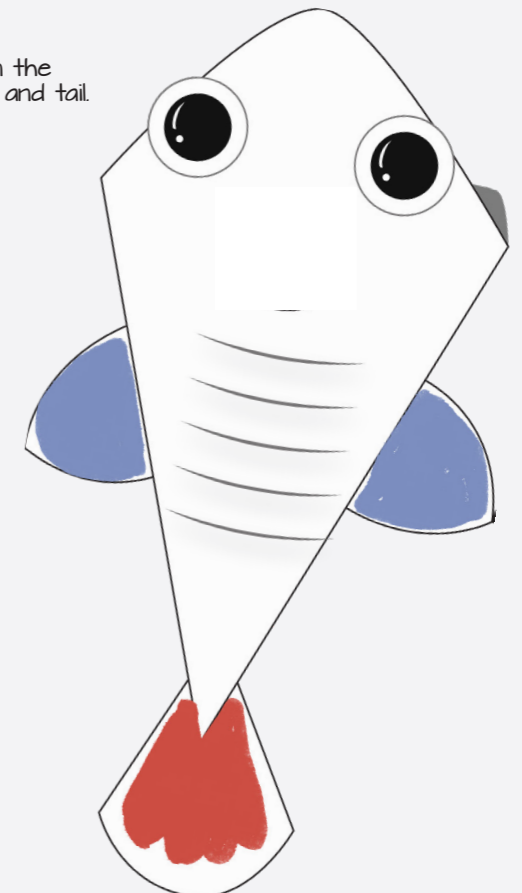
8. Open up your paper. You will notice that only the middle part has been cut.



9. Glue the two flaps of the square paper together to create the body.

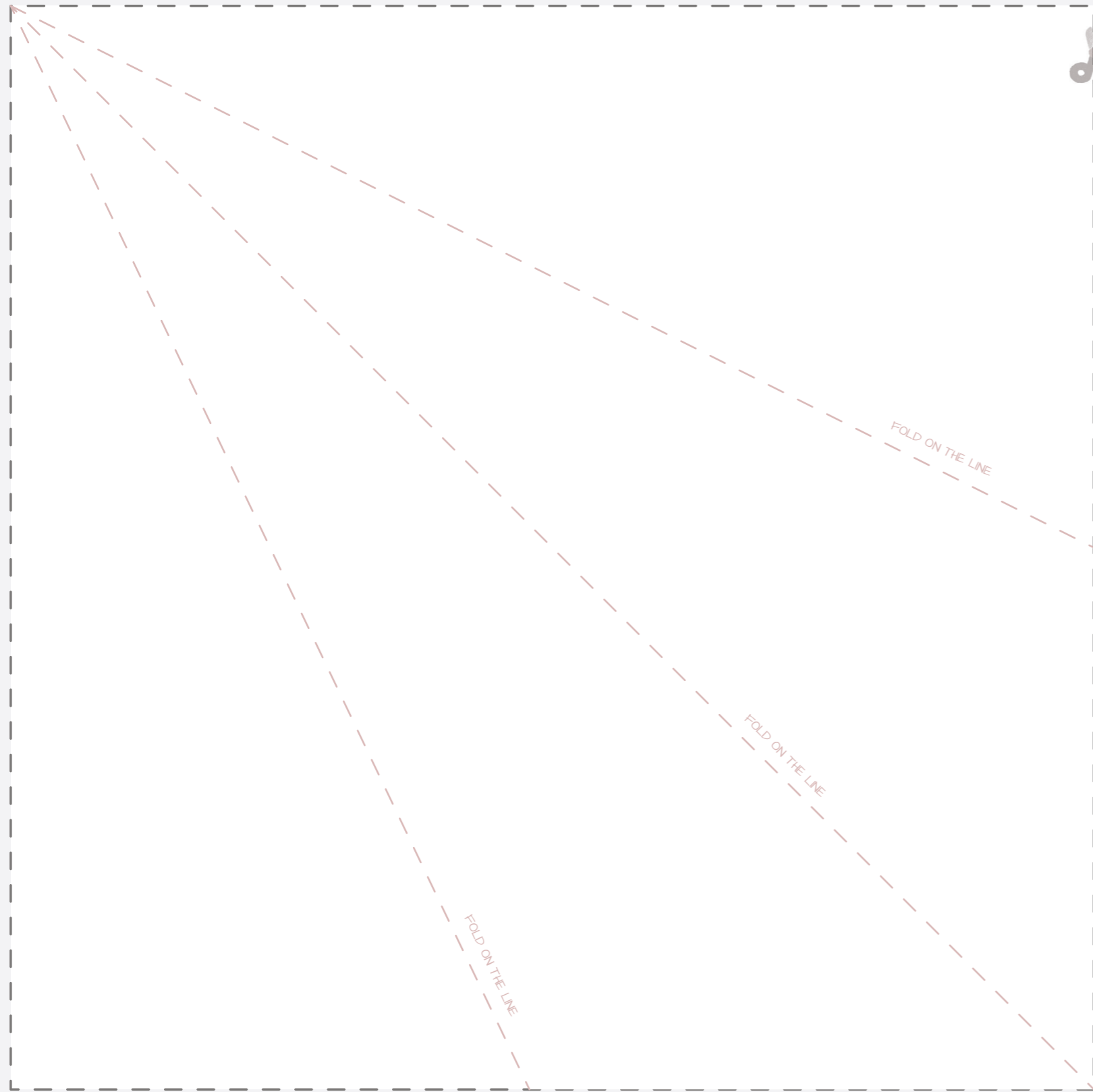


10. Glue on the eyes, fins and tail.

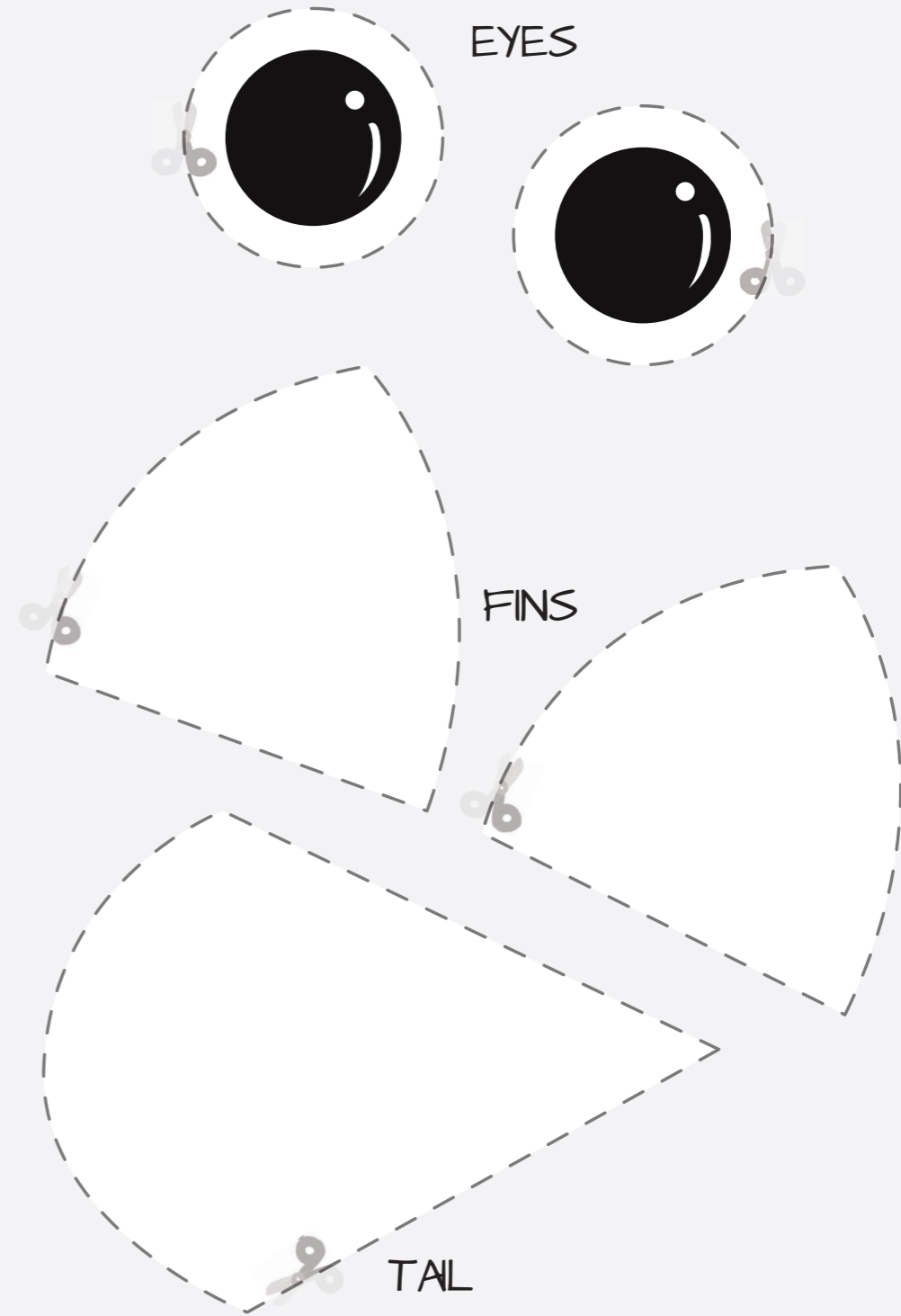
