





Fill in the scene of a rice field with coloured rice.

What you need: 1.3-4 cups of rice



4. Rubbing alcohol or hand gel





2. Food colouring in the colours of your choice




5. Glue





3. Ziploc bags







Instructions:

- 1. Split the rice grains into 3-4 different bags.
- 2. In each bag, add a splash of food colouring of your choice.

You can even mix primary colours to create new colours.

Then, add a small amount of hand gel or rubbing alcohol into each of the bags.

- 3. Here comes the fun part! Zip up the bag. Squish the rice, food colouring and hand gel/rubbing alcohol together. Make sure the colour is well spread and all the rice grains are coloured. Add more food colouring or alcohol if needed. Repeat this with the other remaining bags of rice.
- 4. Tip out the coloured rice onto a clean sheet of paper and let the rice dry.


- 5. Once dried, you can start using it on your artwork.
- 6. Apply glue on the template and stick the coloured rice to bring the scene to life.







If you do not want to use rice, you can simply colour or use colourful crepe paper and roll it into balls and paste it onto the template.
